

Fumigation Information Sheet

Below you will find information that will help you better understand and prepare for your upcoming fumigation.

1. All fumigations contracted by Expert Pest Control, Inc. are subcontracted to our preferred fumigators.

- A. Yourway Fumigators
- B. Beneficial Fumigators
- C. Mega Fume

2. The Fumigator will call you the day before with a time frame unless already specified A.M. or P.M.

3. The day of the Fumigation someone will need to meet the fumigators to give them the keys to the structure. All doors with locks must be left unlocked, all safes must be left open and any cars left in the garage must be unlocked and trunk opened, in order to verify no living animals or humans are left in the structure. Any valuables should be removed.

4. The fumigation will then put the tarp on the structure and introduce warning agent and fumigant. The following day the fumigator will return to ventilate the structure. The third day the fumigator will remove the tarp and clear the structure for re-entry.

5. Occupant will be out of the structure for two (2) nights, three (3) days, the fumigator will try to have structure cleared for re-entry by 12 noon on the third day, the exception to this would be if structure is fumigated on a Friday occupant will be out for three (3) nights, four (4) days fumigator will try to have structure cleared for re-entry by 12 noon on Monday.

CUSTOMER RESPONSIBILITIES

1. Customer must vacate structure for specified time frame.
2. Customer must double bag all foods and medicines not factory sealed in the approved fumigation bags provided by the inspector.
3. Customer must call their Gas Company the day before the fumigation to set an appointment to have their gas service restored. NOTE: (the fumigators will call the gas co. to shut off your gas) it is the customers responsibility to set gas turn on!
