Located on the Best Terroirs of the appellation. Rich, Round and Fruity. This Organic Wine produced from Chardonnay is also characterised by Discreet Toasted Flavours

The wine is Rich with a Honeyed Depth. Citrus notes are fleshed out With Creamy, Warm Brioche notes

A Round, Dry Wine with Full Structure, Tropical Fruit Combined with Mature Fruity Aromas, Peaches, Apple, Pear & Damson Fruit.

Red Wine - France

- 2013 Raisins Gaulois (Gamay), M. Lapierre, Vin de France 40-00
Marcel Lapierre describes this 'natural wine' as something that is not industrial, that respects the place it comes from and the grapes. Light and refreshing with slightly tart red cherry and redcurrant fruit.
- 2012 Chinon Cabernet Franc, Domaine de la Noblaie, Ligre 38-00
- 2011 L'Infidele, Mas Cal Demoura, Coteaux du Languedoc 45-00

Beaujolais

- 2012 Fleurie, Vieilles Vignes, Domain Lucien Lardy 35-00
Old Vines producing small yields of tremendously concentrated juice. Carefully Barrel Aged and has a Big Red Fruit taste

Burgundy

- 2009 Mercurey, Les Champs de L'Abbaye, Alaine et Isabelle Hasard 58-00
Bio-dynamique Pinot Noir produced from this excellent appellation
- 2009 Volnay, Domaine Cyrot-Buthiau, Cote D'Or 70-00
Full of delicate cherry fruit and dark spice, combined with floral and earthy notes, the texture is smooth and silky; extremely elegant and 'feminine'.
- 2007 Gevrey-Chambertin, La Romanee 1er Cru, Domaine des Varoilles 88-00
This offers a terrific tensed aromatic structure combining masculinity, power and finesse. with undertones of candied cherry and plum together with more rusting and darker impressions of wet earth and roasting. The palate is likewise tensed and sappy. It offers great balance and freshness. Tannins are ripe and tender.

Rhone

- 2009 Vacqueyras, Montirius, Le Clos, Bio-dynamique 42-00
- 2010 Chateauneuf-du-Pape, Le Parvis, Ferraton Pere & Fils 65-00
Ink Black, Full-bodied, Strong Flavoured with lots of Fire and Power Complex with nuances of Violets and Spices and Great Finesse

Bordeaux

- 2012 Chateau Le Courolle, Montagne Saint Emillion 39-00
The nose has a Warm Cherry Fruit, Sappy and Spicy with Savoury Nuances and Mocha Hints. The palate mirrors these aromatics, adding A layered Silken Texture with Ripe Tannins
- 2011 Chateau Le Croix des Moines, Lalande de Pomerol 46-00
A lovely Merlot based Bordeaux, Plummy with a Complex Bouquet and Rich Flavour, Structured with Smooth, Silky, Ripe Tannins and hints of Blackcurrant. Very Fine and Elegant
- 2008 Chateau de Lamarque, Cru Bourgeois, Haut-Medoc 56-00
Deep, Glistening, Jet-Ruby. This offers Red and Black Fruit, Roasted Fennel and Mocha Notes on the nose. The palate is underpinned by a Firm, Mineral Structure, Fleshed out with delicately Spiced Ripe Black Fruits supported by Silky, Fine Tannins
- 2003 Chateau Labegorce Zede, Margaux 69-00
- 2007 Les Songs de Magdelaine, Saint Emillion Grand Cru 79-00
Deep ruby in colour. The nose offers stylish, creamy black fruits touched by mint & a palate that has real density, excellent concentration & a subtly extracted structure & freshness to the finish.
- 2003 Chateau Haut-Bages Liberal, Grand Cru, Pauillac 125-00
A dark ruby colour is followed by aromas of cassis, herbs & underbush in this spicy, moderately oaky Pauillac.

Spain

- 2013 Gran Cerdo (Tempranillo), Gonzalo, Spain 28-00
This natural wine Gran Cerdo is all about the purest expression of fruit with whole bunch fermentation, no filtration, no stabilization and minimal sulphur. Gran Cerdo reveals primary notes of fresh fruit, strawberries, raspberries, cherries and violets.
- 2011 Ribera del Duero, Mesomeros de Castilla Roble 35-00
Attractive Wine With Bright Colour & a Good Balance Between Fruit & Oak, Fleshy with a Rich Finish
- 2008 Rioja, Lealtanza Reserva 42-00

Scotland

- Cairn O'Mohr, Elderberry Wine, Perthshire 19-50
A Smooth, Rich Body. A slight Sweetened with Tannins although Well-Balanced

Rich, Mouthfilling & Full Bodied displaying Soft, Round palate & a Complex Persistant Taste

Organic Cabernet Sauvignon and Cinsault. Full of Spiced Blackcurrant Flavours. Two years in Oak adds Power, Complexity and Richness

Aromas of Cherries, Figs and Red Fruit. A Complex palate with Soft Tannins and a touch of Earthiness. Organic and Bio-dynamique

Dark cherries and cream with a hint of coffee and mocha too
