

### RICHMOND FLYING SQUIRRELS ALL-STAR LEGACY SCHOLARSHIP

All completed applications must be submitted by email to <a href="mailto:scholarships@grasp4va.org">scholarships@grasp4va.org</a> or mailed to GRASP, 2821 Emerywood Parkway, Suite 204, Richmond, VA 23294 by <a href="May 31">May 31</a>, 2023. Only complete applications will be considered.

Through the Richmond Flying Squirrels All-Star Legacy Scholarship, Richmond Flying Squirrels Charities and partners will honor RVA region students who are committed to improving their community and are involved in an athletic sport. One student will receive a \$5,000 renewable award, and two students will receive a \$1,000 renewable award.

### **Qualifications:**

- Have met with a GReat Aspirations Scholarship Program, Inc. (GRASP) advisor and filed a Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA).
- Will graduate from an RVA region\* high school in spring of 2023.
- Will attend a four-year college or university, community college, or junior college in the upcoming academic year.
- Demonstrate unmet financial need (a college financial aid award letter will be requested before scholarship is granted).
- Have participated in a school or community athletic sport during high school.
- Scholarships are renewable if recipient is a full-time student in good standing at their college or university and has at least a 2.5 average GPA.

### **Considerations for Selection:**

- Community Service: Student must show a strong passion and interest in the community and needs to have demonstrated so in a concrete manner. Service can be with school, church, or community organizations.
- Athletics: Student must have participated in an athletic sport during high school through school or community organizations.
- Academic Rigor: It is important that students took a challenging academic high school curriculum. The
  course selection is, therefore, important since it may be indicative of the student's drive, perseverance,
  ability, and desire to succeed.
- *GPA*: A strong GPA is desirable; however, this will be considered in context of the student's circumstances, among other factors.

<sup>\*</sup> Public or private high school or home school located in Ashland, Charles City, Chesterfield, Goochland, Hanover, Henrico, New Kent, Powhatan, or Richmond. If applicant attends a public high school, contact the high school counseling department to set up an appointment with a GRASP advisor.
