Child Care Software Coming to Kid Zone

Over the next few weeks Kid Zone will be implementing new child care software that will modernize our operations and make it easier for you to work with Kid Zone. Here are the highlights of the software and how it will help to make your parent experience even better!

- <u>New Child Sign In and Sign Out Feature:</u> On each floor of Kid Zone, you'll find a wall mounted kiosk where you can quickly sign your child in and out each day simply using a finger print or a pin unique to your family. More details will be shared in the coming weeks. This new technology will provide documentation of your transition of care to and from Kid Zone, which is a requirement of our licensing agreement with the State of Minnesota.
- <u>New Parent Texting Feature</u>: We'll be able to send individual or group texts to parents as a quick way
 to make you aware of important Kid Zone information (e.g., Kid Zone is closed due to significant snow
 fall).
