

DAWN AND MACK RAISE THEIR ARMS IN THE AIR AND START ULULATING. RICKY IMMEDIATELY STOPS THEM.

RICKY

Before you Gandorks do that, INDICATING) Derek Moses is coming this way.

DEREK MOSES, A COOL KID IN THEIR CLASS, APPROACHES WITH HIS COLLAR UP AND SUNGLASSES ON.

DICKY

(TO NATLEE) He might be the coolest kid in school, but I'm a close second. (LEANS IN) Very close.

NATLEE

The only thing you're very close to is my face.

MOSES WALKS UP WITH SWAGGER. THE KIDS ALL AD-LIB HELLOS.

START

DICKY

Moses, my man. (RE: CHAIR) Grab some plastic.

MOSES

No, I don't sit in groups. It's one of my ten cool-mandments. It's right behind "always wear your collar up and shades inside." That cool-mandment has two subsets.

NICKY/RICKY/DICKY

(SOTTO) He's so cool. / How does he do it? / What's a subset?

MOSES

What's the small talk du jour?

NATLEE

(SOTTO) Whoa, he speaks French.

DAWN

We're talkin' Hungry Wars.

MACK

We're seeing it tonight.

MOSES

Well I hope you're gonna follow

Moses's cool-mandment number one:

"Never see a movie with your parents."

NICKY, RICKY, AND DICKY LAUGH THIS OFF.

NICKY

We're way past that. We've been in the mall without our parents, stayed home alone without a babysitter.

RICKY

We're very evolved.

DICKY

Yeah, we're hardly ever around our parents.

TOM APPROACHES WITH A TRAY OF DRINKS.

TON

Daddy's got some smoothies for his little Quaddie-waddies.

TOM KISSES DAWN ON THE TOP OF THE HEAD THEN STARTS HANDING OUT DRINKS. MOSES GIVES THE QUADS A SUSPICIOUS LOOK.

DAWN

(COVERING) We just hang out here for the free smoothies.

MOSES NODS, APPROVINGLY. TOM FINISHES HANDING OUT THE DRINKS AND OSCAR'S OMELETTE. THE KIDS START SIPPING THEIR SMOOTHIES.

MOSES

Cool-mandment number seven, "Sip slowly -- no one looks cool with a brain freeze."

THE KIDS ALL GET BRAIN FREEZE.

TOM

Whoa, this kid knows what he's talking about. Dig your style young man.

TOM POPS HIS COLLAR UP AND CROSSES OFF.

MOSES

Now I'll leave you with cool-mandment number six -- "Always use your name in your exit line." (THEN) I'm gonna go mosey on over there.

MOSES WALKS OVER TO A TABLE, SITS BY HIMSELF, AND STRIKES A END

NICKY

(STILL BRAINFREEZED) He's so cool.

THE OTHER KIDS NOD

MACK

(TO DAWN) I should get going. See you Mack tonight. (OFF THEIR LOOKS) That exit line didn't work, did it?

START -

DICKY

Derek Moses. What an honor!

MOSES

You guys having a secret conversation?

RICKY

(NERVOUS) What? No.

NICKY

(NERVOUS) This is just how we talk. We call it a Quaddle.

MOSES

I don't know what that means but it just got a lot cooler.

DICKY

(TO BROTHERS) He's not wrong.

RICKY

Anyway, we have to get going.

MOSES

Why? You're not here with your

parents, are you?

RICKY/NICKY/DICKY

Whaaaaat?! / No way! / Parents are for kids.

MOSES

Sweet. Then you can be my teammates for Zombie Battlefield 4.

MOSES POINTS TO A VIDEO GAME NEARBY. THE BOYS EXCHANGE A NERVOUS LOOK.

MOSES (CONT'D)

Cool-mandment number three says to always trust your gut. And right now, my gut is telling me... you guys are up to something.

THE BOYS LAUGH A LITTLE TOO NERVOUSLY.

RICKY

Yeah, up to kicking your zombie butt!

MOSES

Sweet! Let's do it!

MOSES HEADS OVER TO THE VIDEO GAMES. THE BOYS EXCHANGE WORRIED LOOKS, THEN PUT ON HUGE SMILES WHEN MOSES TURNS TO THEM.

DICKY

Oh, it will be done!

THEY FOLLOW HIM OFF, AS WE...

END

CUT TO:

DAWN (CONT'D)

But that's the end of the line for the Popcornado. It wraps around the whole lobby and ends there.

MOT

Wow. If the line's that long, the boys will miss the movie. I'm gonna go tell them not to bother waiting.

DAWN, NOT WANTING TO EXPOSE HERSELF, GRABS TOM'S ARM FROM HER SEAT, STOPPING HIM.

DAWN

No, you can't leave Mom to save all these seats.

ANGLE ON: ANNE. SHE LOOKS LIKE A GOALIE WITH HER ARMS SPREAD OUT OVER THE EMPTY SEATS, REEPING AN EYE OUT FOR SEAT-STEALERS.

DAWN (CONTYD)

You sit. I'll call and tell the boys to come in.

TOM SITS AS DAWN DIALS HER PHONE.

INTERCUT WITH:

C-2: INT. BRISTER SIX THEATERS - LOBBY - CONTINUOUS (NIGHT 1)
(Nicky, Ricky, Dicky, Dawn, Moses, Extras)

THE FOLLOWING IS INTERCUT WITH DAWN ON THE PHONE IN THE THEATER. RICKY IS PLAYING VIDEO GAMES, NEXT TO DICKY, NICKY AND MOSES. RICKY NOTICES IT'S DAWN ON HIS CALLER ID.

SC3

RICKY

(TO MOSES) Gotta take this a sec.

Cool-mandment number nine: "Never stop playing your video game to take a call."

RICKY

I can do both. (CONTINUES PLAYING GAME, ANSWERS CELL, STILTED) Yes, hello. Ricky Harper's phone. (OFF MOSES'S LOOK) I mean, what up?

DAWN

(SOTTO) What are you guys doing?!
You're supposed to be keeping an eye
on Mack. But you're trying to beat
your high scores, aren't you?

RICKY

(STILTED) That is incorrect.

DAWN

What's that supposed to mean?
RICKY

That you are Morrect.

DAWN

Why are you talking like that?

RICKY

Do the math. (TO MOSES, RE: CALL)
Helping a friend with math homework.

Whoa, cool-mandment number one: "Never help a friend with homework."

RICKY

I thought cool-mandment number one was: "Never see a movie with your parents"?

MOSES

Cool-mandment number nine: "Don't get hung up on numbers."

RICKY

END

(BACK ON PHONE, SOTTO) So if there are only three "Y's," but then suddenly an "X" was added to the equation, it might cause a much bigger mathematical problem that needed to be solved.

DAWN

Ricky, you know I'm not good at math.

And that doesn't even sound like math.

I give you guys one job. One job! I'm coming out there.

DAWN PULLS HER JACKET UP AND STANDS TO SO. ANNE STOPS HER.

ANNE

Honey, where are you going? Everybody wants these seats.

SCENE D

INT. BRISTER SIX THEATERS - LOBBY - MOMENTS LATER - (NIGHT 1)
(Nicky, Ricky, Dicky, Dawn, Mack, Moses, Extras)

DAWN MARCHES TOWARD NICKY, RICKY, AND DICKY WITH A HEAD OF STEAM.

START -

DAWN

I can't believe you guys! How can you be playing video games when Mom and Dad are sitting right...

WIDEN TO SEE: MOSES WAS DUCKED BELOW FRAME PUTTING QUARTERS INTO THE MACHINE. HE'S STARING AT DAWN.

DAWN (CONT'D)

(NOTICING MOSES) ...on the sofa in the living room at home nowhere near this theater.

MOSES

What's going on? You guys have all been acting kinda weird.

RICKY

This is how we always act. You've gotta remember, we are not nearly as cool as you.

MOSES

Oh, I remember.

DAWN

Speaking of things that are "not cool," guess who I just saw with their Mom? Mya and Gerald Dinkler.

DAWN POINTS TO SOME KIDS WITH THEIR PARENTS.

NICKY

Sounds like someone needs some schooling on the "cool-mandments."

MOSES

(SHAKES HEAD) And not too soon. (TO BOYS) Mosey gotta blows-ey.

MOSES STARTS TO RUSH OFF.

DAWN

Do you guys have any idea where Mack is? You were supposed to be keeping an eye on him?

RICKY

Yeah, and what have <u>you</u> been doing, Dawn?

DA VN

Hello, I've been trying to hide from him.

NICKY

Well you might want to try a little harder. 'Cause there he is.

DAWN TURNS AND SEES MACK WALK INTO A THEATER WITH A SIGN FOR HUNGRY WARS.

DAWN

He's seeing Hungry Wars without me?

DAWN

Oh no, Mack just went into our theater.

NICKY

This is bad.

DAWN

I have to delete that message before he hears it.

RICKY

No, we all do. We need to get Mack's phone.

MOSES WALKED UP IN TIME TO HEAR THIS.

MOSES

Why do you need Mack's phone?

RICKY

Um, I didn't say Mack's phone. I said... Zach's cone.

DAWN

Yep, our friend Zach lost his cone and we're helping him find it.

MOSES

(SUSPICIOUS) What kind of cone?

NICKY/RICKY/DICKY

Ice cream. / Orange construction. /
Dog.

DAWN

He's a cone guy.

My gut tells me you guys are up to something un-cool and as the coolest kid in school, I can't allow that. I'm gonna get Mack's phone and find out what's going on. Mosey gots to goes-y.

MOSES WALKS OFF.

DICKY

If Moses hears that voicemail, he's gonna know we broke the biggest cool-mandment of all

THE QUADS SEE MOSES SCANNING THE LOBBY FOR MACK.

DAWN

He doesn't know where Mack went.

RICKY

Let's lead him to the wrong theater.

DICKY

(FOR MOSES'S BENEFIT) Hurry, Mack went this way!

THE QUADS HEAD TOWARD A HALLWAY THAT LEADS TO MORE THEATERS. MOSES SPOTS THEM AND RUNS AHEAD OF THEM.

MOSES

Nice try, Harpers! Moses runs cross country.

MOSES RUNS OFF DOWN THE HALLWAY. THE QUADS STOP RUNNING.

END

DAWN

Okay, let's go.

RICKY

Because we need to plan better.

DAWN SNATCHES THE PHONE FROM MACK.

DAWN

(TO MACK) In you go!

RICKY HANDS MACK A BUCKET, THEN DICKY BUMPS THE DOOR SHUT. RICKY TURNS THE POPCORNATOR ON. MACK IS SUDDENLY SHROUDED BY A TORNADO OF POPCORN. AS A HAPPY MACK TRIES TO CATCH AS MUCH POPCORN AS POSSIBLE, DAWN TRIES TO DELETE HER MESSAGE.

DAWN (CONT'D)

(RE: PHONE) Come on, delete!

RICKY

What's taking you so long?

DAWN

My fingers are all buttery.

NICKY

I'd make a butter fingers joke, but this is no time for laughs.

RICKY

(TO DAWN) Here, give it to me.

DAWN HANDS RICKY THE PHONE. HE STRUGGLES TO DELETE IT TOO.

RICKY (CONT'D)

I can't do it either.

MOSES APPROACHES.

MOSES

Can't do what? And who are you people?

NICKY/DICKY/RICKY

(SAME TIME) Kernel Crew. / Popcorn

Peeps. / Brister Bucket Heads.

DAWN

We've really gotta work on that.

MOSES

Wait, is that the Harpers in there?

MOSES TRIES TO PEEK IN THEIR BUCKETS.

DAWN

Uh... it's rude to look under a

person's bucket.

THE QUADS ALL TURN TO EACH OTHER WITH THEIR BUCKET HEADS. NICKY'S BUCKET TURNS, SHIFTING HIS EYE HOLES SO HE CAN'T SEE. THEN RICKY, DAWN, AND DICKY RUN OFF.

MACK

Hey! Where are you going with my

phone?!

NICKY

My eye holes! W pre'd they go?

NICKY PEEKS FROM UNDER HIS BUCKET TO SEE HIS SIBLINGS HAVE RUN OFF. MOSES IS STARING AT HIM.

MOSES

Oh, whatever's on that phone is goooood. Moses gots to knowses.

NICKY

Uh-oh.

NICKY QUICKLY LOWERS HIS BUCKET AND (STUNT DOUBLE) RUNS STRAIGHT INTO A MASSIVE GUY, THEN PINBALLS BACK INTO THE BOOTH, BOUNCES OFF, THEN TURNS AND RUNS OFF AFTER HIS SIBLINGS. MOSES RUNS AFTER HIM.

(LAUGHS, THEN) I knew it. You guys broke cool-mandment number one.

MACK

Dawn? I thought you were sick. You typed "cough" and everything. What's going on?

DAWN LOOKS TO THE CROWD.

DAWN

When I asked my parents if I could see Hungry Wars with you, they said only if they chaperoned. But I was too embarrassed to break cool-mandment number one.

MACK

(CONFUSED) So you put on a popcorn bucket head and stole my phone?

DAWN

Only because when I saw you go into Hungry Wars, I thought you were seeing it without me. So I kinda got mad--

NICKY

"Kinda"?

DAWN

--And I sorta left a mean message--

RICKY

"Sorta"?

DICKY

(TO MACK) She Dawn-dialed you.

MACK

(GASPS) Like you did with your Aunt

Gilda?

AWN

Worse. (HANDS MACK HIS PHONE) Here. If you could just erase it without listening, I'd appreciate it. (SINCERE) I'm sorry, Mack. I should have just told you the truth. And none of this would have ever happened if I wasn't so worred about being seen at the movies with my parents.

DAWN INDICATES TOM AND ANNE, WHO ARE COCKILY WAVING GOODBYE TO THE SITTER. THEY STOP AND SMILE TO DAWN, THEN RESUME TAUNTING THE SITTER.

MACK

I get it. The only reason I snuck into Hungry Wars was 'cause I saw Moses in the lobby. And I was with...

(INDICATES THE ATTRACTIVE WOMAN NEXT TO HIM) my mom.

DICKY

(SOTTO TO NICKY AND RICKY) Play date at Mack's.

MACK

So, I guess we're both uncool together.

MOSES

I thought you guys were cool, but you've given me no choice but to let everyone know just how uncool you are.

A KID WHO HAS BEEN SLUMPED DOWN IN HER SEAT WITH HER HOOD PULLED UP, STANDS AND ADDRESSES THE CROWD.

NATLEE

Then you'll have to let everyone how uncool I am, too. I'm with my parents.

SHE REMOVES HER HOOD, REVEALING IT'S NATLEE.

NICKY

Natlee?

NATLEE INDICATES HER PARENTS SEATED NEXT TO HER. THEY STAND AND WAVE. ANOTHER KID SLUMPED DOWN IN HIS SEAT, WITH HIS NEWSBOY HAT PULLED DOWN AND BIG "OLD MAN" SUNGLASSES, STANDS AND REMOVES HIS HAT AND SUNGLASSES, REVEALING IT'S OSCAR.

OSCAR

You guys aren't the only ones.

OSCAR INDICATES HIS OLDER PARENTS, WHO STRUGGLE TO STAND.

OSCAR (CONT'D)

(TO HIS PARENTS) You don't have to get

up.

THE TEENAGER FROM THE LOBBY STANDS UP, REMOVES HIS HOOD, AND INDICATES HIS PARENTS.

TEENA GER

Here with my parents too.

A FEW OTHER KIDS STAND, ONE-BY-ONE, REMOVING THEIR HOODIES AS WELL, GESTURING TO THEIR PARENTS.

I AWN

Wow, there's so many of us here.

RICKY

I guess we should have never been worried about being embarrassed.

MOSES

No, you should have. You guys are pathetic. Am I the only kid in Boulder cool enough to be here without my parents?

MRS. MOSES'S MOTHER, POPS HER HEAD OUT OF THE PROJECTOR BOOTH.

MRS. MOSES

Derek Francis Moses, stop pretending you're unsupervised. Go back to the break room and do your homework.

MOSES

Not cool, Mom!

SOME KIDS LAUGH.

DICKY

"Francis"?

THE KIDS LAUGH AGAIN.

MOSES

Also not cool!

EMBARRASSED, MOSES RUNS OFF.
