Young Men Uniform Options

Shirt Options:

- Burgundy or gray St. Benedict Preparatory embroidered knit polo shirt
- White oxford St. Benedict Preparatory embroidered long or short sleeve shirt with burgundy tie

- Blue and white striped St. Benedict Preparatory embroidered long or short sleeve shirt with burgundy tie

Shorts: (from beginning of School to October 15th and from April 15th -end of school only)

Shoes:

- Black dress shoes
- DRESS SHOES ARE leather top shoes
- Leather top gym shoes are not allowed
- When wearing shorts may wear SOLID white gym shoes
- NO Sandals, flip flops, boots, slipper style, open toe and open back shoes

Young Women Uniform Options

Shirt Options:

- Burgundy or gray St. Benedict Preparatory embroidered knit polo shirt.
- White oxford St. Benedict Preparatory embroidered long or short sleeve shirt (burgundy tie optional)

Sweater/Jacket Options:

Skirts/Pants:

- Burgundy and gray plaid kilt (available from Lands' End in mid-July)
- Lands' End khaki skirt
- Lands' End khaki pants (must wear a black or brown belt)

Shorts: (from beginning of School to October 15th and April 15th -end of school only)

- Lands' End khaki shorts

Hosiery: SOCKS MUST BE WORN WITH SHOES

- Navy blue, maroon, or white ankle socks
- Navy blue, maroon, or white knee socks
- Maroon or gray tights

Shoes:

- Black dress shoes
- DRESS SHOES ARE leather top shoes
- Leather top gym shoes are not allowed
- When wearing shorts may wear SOLID white gym shoes
- NO Sandals, flip flops, boots, high heels, slipper style, open toe and open back shoes

Gym Uniform for Both Young Men and Women

The PE uniform is to be worn during PE class

- Maroon or gray sweatpants
- Maroon or gray sweatshirt (may also be worn on Spirit Days)
- Maroon shorts
- Gym T-shirt (long and short sleeve option)

The following additional guidelines apply to all students:

- No jewelry should be worn around the neck except for crosses and small necklaces.
- Hair should be professional in appearance and in good taste. It should avoid exaggerated styles or colors (i.e., lines designs, two-tones) and it should not cause undue attention.
- Male students are to be clean shaven. If a student needs to shave at school a \$5.00 charge for supplies will be assessed to the individual. If the student has multiple violations for not shaving-the student will be sent home for the remainder of the day and must return to school for a parent meeting with the Assistant Head of Secondary School.
- Hats and all headgear (including hooded sweatshirts) are not to be worn in the building at any time.
- Students must dress in school uniforms during any school function during the school day. This includes Days of Reflection, field trips, pep rallies or any school function not mentioned here unless otherwise excused.
- No female student should have more than two earrings in either ear. No other type of body piercing is allowed.
- Piercing(s) are not permitted for male students.
- No visible tattoos are allowed in school, at school-sponsored events, or at sporting events.

Spirit Days:

On special dress code days known as spirit days students are to wear the following items:

- Jeans in good repair, free from holes on any part of the clothing item or other modest style pants (worn at the waist with a belt)
- Bengal wear purchased online at the Spirit Store
- In-season sports jerseys if the team coach permits
- Gym shoes or other appropriate shoe item
- Uniform shirts, pants, and shoes
- Pajama bottoms are not allowed

- NO HOODED Sweatshirts may be worn in school during class time; HOODS MUST BE DOWN AT ALL TIMES IN THE SCHOOL BUILDING
- NO sandals, flip flops, boots, high heels, slipper style, open toe and open back shoes

Dress Code on Campus - Before School or when School Day is Over:

- Students are expected to come to school dressed in proper uniform attire. They are not to get dressed at their locker in the morning.
- Clothing such as tank-tops, T-shirts, half-shirts, flannel shirts or sweatpants, pajama bottoms (plain or with designs) are not permitted.
- Clothing with pictures, sayings, numbers, or athletic teams are not permitted.
- Dresses with spaghetti straps or no straps, halter tops, low-cut, bare midriffs or sleeveless blouses are not permitted.
- Hats or coats during school are not permitted. Any type of headgear is never permitted to be worn in the building.
- Gloves may not be worn in the building.
- Military clothing, gang clothing or clothing containing insignias/writing, which could be interpreted as gang-related, may not be worn.
- Clothing with names of other schools may not be worn to or in school.
- Students are discouraged from wearing leather outerwear, “Starter”-like outerwear, expensive jewelry, or from bringing large sums of money to school. The school cannot assume responsibility for lost, damaged, or stolen items.
- Silver chains that extend from the belt loop and pockets are not allowed
- Stomachs are never to be seen during out-of-dress code days. If the stomach is visible, detentions may be written.

ADMINISTRATIVE DISCRETION:

If there is a question regarding any article of clothing, the final decision rests with the discretion of the administration.
