


Dash:

Starfall Quilt and Pillow by Stacey Day



Yardage

Fabric A	CSNE W* (solid white)	2 yards
Fabric B	DASH 600 LS	1/2 yard
Fabric C	DASH 600 YG	3/4 yard
Fabric D	DASH 600 T	1/3 yard
Fabric E	DASH 600 P	1/3 yard
Fabric F	DASH 600 N	1/4 yard
Fabric G	DASH 600 LB	1/3 yard
Fabric H	DASH 600 LJ	1/4 yard
Fabric I	DASH 600 C	1/3 yard
Fabric J	DASH 600 AU	1/3 yard
Backing:	any DASH fabric	3 1/2 yards

Cutting

All strips are cut across the width of the fabric.

From Fabric A (CSNE W), cut:

- (3) 6 1/2" x 42" strips; cut into (16) 6 1/2" squares
- (6) 3 7/8" x 42" strips; cut into (56) 3 7/8" squares. Cut the squares in half diagonally to yield (112) half-square triangles.
- (5) 3 1/2" x 42" strips; cut into (56) 3 1/2" squares

From Fabric B (DASH 600 LS), cut:

- (3) 3 7/8" x 42" strips; cut into (28) 3 7/8" squares. Cut the squares in half diagonally to yield (56) half-square triangles.

From Fabric C (DASH 600 YG), cut:

- (6) 2 1/4" x 42" strips
- (2) 3 7/8" x 42" strips; cut into (11) 3 7/8" squares. Cut the squares in half diagonally to yield (22) half-square triangles, discard 1.

From Fabric D (DASH 600 T), cut:

- (2) 3 7/8" x 42" strips; cut into (12) 3 7/8" squares. Cut the squares in half diagonally to yield (24) half-square triangles.

From Fabric E (DASH 600 P), cut:

- (2) 3 7/8" x 42" strips; cut into (14) 3 7/8" squares. Cut the squares in half diagonally to yield (28) half-square triangles, discard 1.

From Fabric F (DASH 600 N), cut:

- (1) 3 7/8" x 42" strips; cut into (9) 3 7/8" squares. Cut the squares in half diagonally to yield (18) half-square triangles.

From Fabric G (DASH 600 LB), cut:

- (2) 3 7/8" x 42" strips; cut into (11) 3 7/8" squares. Cut the squares in half diagonally to yield (22) half-square triangles, discard 1.

From Fabric H (DASH 600 LJ), cut:

- (1) 3 7/8" x 42" strips; cut into (8) 3 7/8" squares. Cut the squares in half diagonally to yield (16) half-square triangles, discard 1.

From Fabric I (DASH 600 C), cut:

- (2) 3 7/8" x 42" strips; cut into (11) 3 7/8" squares. Cut the squares in half diagonally to yield (22) half-square triangles, discard 1.

From Fabric J (DASH 600 AU), cut:

- (2) 3 7/8" x 42" strips; cut into (11) 3 7/8" squares. Cut the squares in half diagonally to yield (22) half-square triangles, discard 1.

Making the Blocks


1. Sew the Fabric B half-square triangles to the half-square triangles of the Fabric C through J on the diagonal as follows to make the Contrast Squares:


2. Sew the remaining Fabric C through J half-square rectangles to the Fabric A half-square triangles on the diagonal to make the following Accent Squares:


3. Sew (7) $3\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric A squares, the Fabric C Accent Squares and Fabric C Contrast Squares together into 7 Starfall Blocks as shown, paying close attention to the placement and orientation of the Accent Squares and Contrast Squares. Repeat for the remaining Fabric A squares and the Fabric D through J Accent Squares and Contrast Squares to make the following Starfall Blocks:

- 7 of Fabric C
- 8 of Fabric D
- 9 of Fabric E
- 6 of Fabric F
- 7 of Fabric G
- 5 of Fabric H
- 7 of Fabric I
- 7 of Fabric J



Assembling the Quilt Top

4. Lay out the $6\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric A squares and the Starfall Blocks as shown in the quilt assembly diagram, paying close attention to the placement and orientation of each block. Join the blocks into rows and then join the rows.



5. Layer the quilt top with batting and backing; baste. Quilt as desired. Using the Fabric C $2\frac{1}{4}$ "-wide binding strips, bind the edges to finish.

Starfall Pillow by Stacey Day • Size: 12" square

Yardage

This cute pillow can be made using scraps from the quilt. You will need a 12" Pillow Form.

Cutting

From Fabric A (CSNE W), cut:

- (4) $3\frac{7}{8}$ " squares. Cut the squares in half diagonally to yield 8 half-square triangles.
- (4) $3\frac{1}{2}$ " squares

From Fabrics B, C, D, E and F cut:

- (2) $3\frac{7}{8}$ " squares. Cut the squares in half diagonally to yield 4 half-square triangles. Discard one of each.

From backing, cut:

- (2) $8" \times 2\frac{1}{2}"$ rectangles.

Making the Blocks


1. Following Steps 1–3 of the quilt instructions, make one block of each Fabric C, D, E and F.


Assembling the Pillow

2. Layer block, batting and muslin. Quilt as desired. Trim backing and batting to be even with the pillow top.

3. Turn one long side of an $8" \times 12\frac{1}{2}"$ rectangle backing under $\frac{1}{4}"$ and press. Turn under again and stitch. Repeat with the other backing piece.

4. Lay the block right side up. Place one of the backing pieces right side down, on top of one edge of the pillow, with the stitched edge in the center. Pin the 3 sides. Stitch the 3 pinned sides with a $\frac{1}{4}"$ seam allowance, back stitching at both stitched edges. Repeat with the other backing piece. The two pieces will overlap allowing a pillow form to be inserted. Trim the corners. Turn the pillow to the right side. Using a blunt tool, poke the corners out.







