- 1:00 p.m. Junior Heifer Show: conformation classes (commercial calves, commercial yearlings, purebred calves, purebred yearlings) followed by showmanship classes. Showmanship classes will be held for the following age groups: \*Peewee, Junior (9 - 14), and Senior (15 - 21)

*\*The Peewee class is open to all children under the age of 9 (nine) as of January 1, 2015. In consideration of the young age of these children, it is recommended that the animals which they are showing be of good temperament and extremely well trained.*

## **JUNIOR SHOW RULES AND REGULATIONS:**

1. Exhibitors must be at least 9 and not more than 21 years of age on January 1, 2015.
2. Exhibitors must be a junior, annual or life member of the Canadian Angus Association at the time their entry is submitted (May 15, 2015 or earlier).
3. Exhibitors may show only one animal in each class. Substitutes will not be accepted. Cross bred animals cannot show in the championship class.
4. Each purebred entry must include the NAME, DATE OF BIRTH, and REGISTRATION NUMBER AND TATTOO of the animal. Tattoos will be checked on show day.
5. Entries will be listed in the catalogue in order of animal's age, and will be led into the ring in order of catalogue entry number. Classes will be split, depending on the number of entries.
6. Each exhibitor must submit a copy of their animal(s) liability insurance(s) and registration certificate(s) with their entry form.
7. Official CAA show vests must be worn by exhibitors. These may be rented (\$10) on show day from Betty Lou.
8. Deadline for entries is May 15, 2015. PLEASE COMPLY WITH ENTRY DATE.
