## Summer Camp Programs

### Upward Bound

Upward Bound is CBH's signature first year scout program. The program focusing on teaching basic camping skills & the patrol method. During the program scouts will complete First Class requirements.

### Merit Badges

Each summer, CBH offers a wide range of merit badges. We are constantly changing our Merit Badge selection to challenge our returning scouts. We tend to offer more than 40 badges each summer ranging from Eagle required to just for fun.

### High Adventure Programs

CBH offers a variety of High Adventure Programs designed to challenge the older scouts. Our High Adventure Program accents the our mountain mountainous background.

### COPE / Climbing

Project COPE provides an opportunity for each participant to achieve success as an individual and as a member of a team. The emphasis of COPE is outlined in the seven principles: Leadership, Teamwork, Communications, Problem Solving, Self Esteem, Decision Making, & Trust.

### Mountain Man

Come along on our adventure back to the early 1800's. This program will take your boys on a primitive interactive history of the Fur Trade Era. They will have the opportunity to learn everything from black powder, rope making, and log building construction, tomahawk throwing, and cooking on open fire

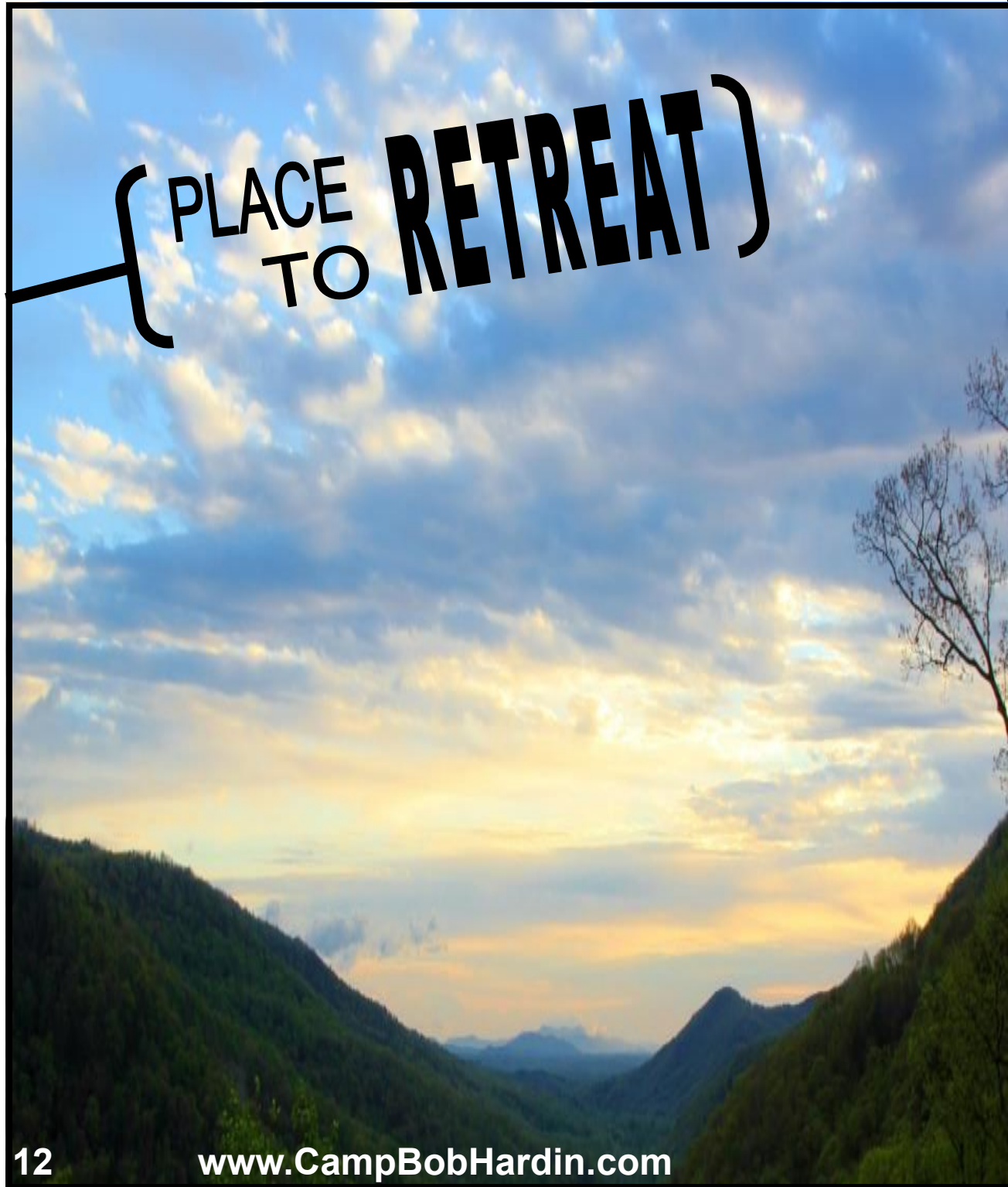
### Mountain Biking

CBH has 16 Adirondacks that sleep 8 each. Open year round.

### CABIN SITE

The Seneca campsite has 5 cabins that sleep 4 each. This campsite is open year round and joins the Ottawa tent site.

### COMBO SITE

The Sioux campsite sleeps a total of 34. This campsite offers 3 cabins, 6 tent platforms, & 1 bunkhouse that sleeps 6. This campsite also has it's own bathroom & shower facility.

## Housing Options

### BUNK HOUSE 1 A & B

Bunk House 3 is divided into an A & B section. Each sections can sleep 5 and has a bathroom.

### BUNK HOUSE 2

Bunk House 2 can sleep 12 . This house has 2 bathrooms.

### BUNK HOUSE 3

Bunk House 1 sleeps 8 people on cots. This Bunk House has AC/Heat, a large shower facility, washer, & dryer.

### SARAH HARDIN HOUSE

The SHH has 2 beds, a small kitchen, and living room. Open year round, however, without water November - March.

### HEALTH LODGE

The Health Lodge can also be used as a housing option. The HL can sleep 8 and has 2 bathrooms.

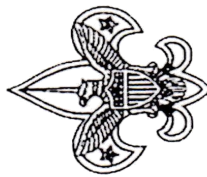
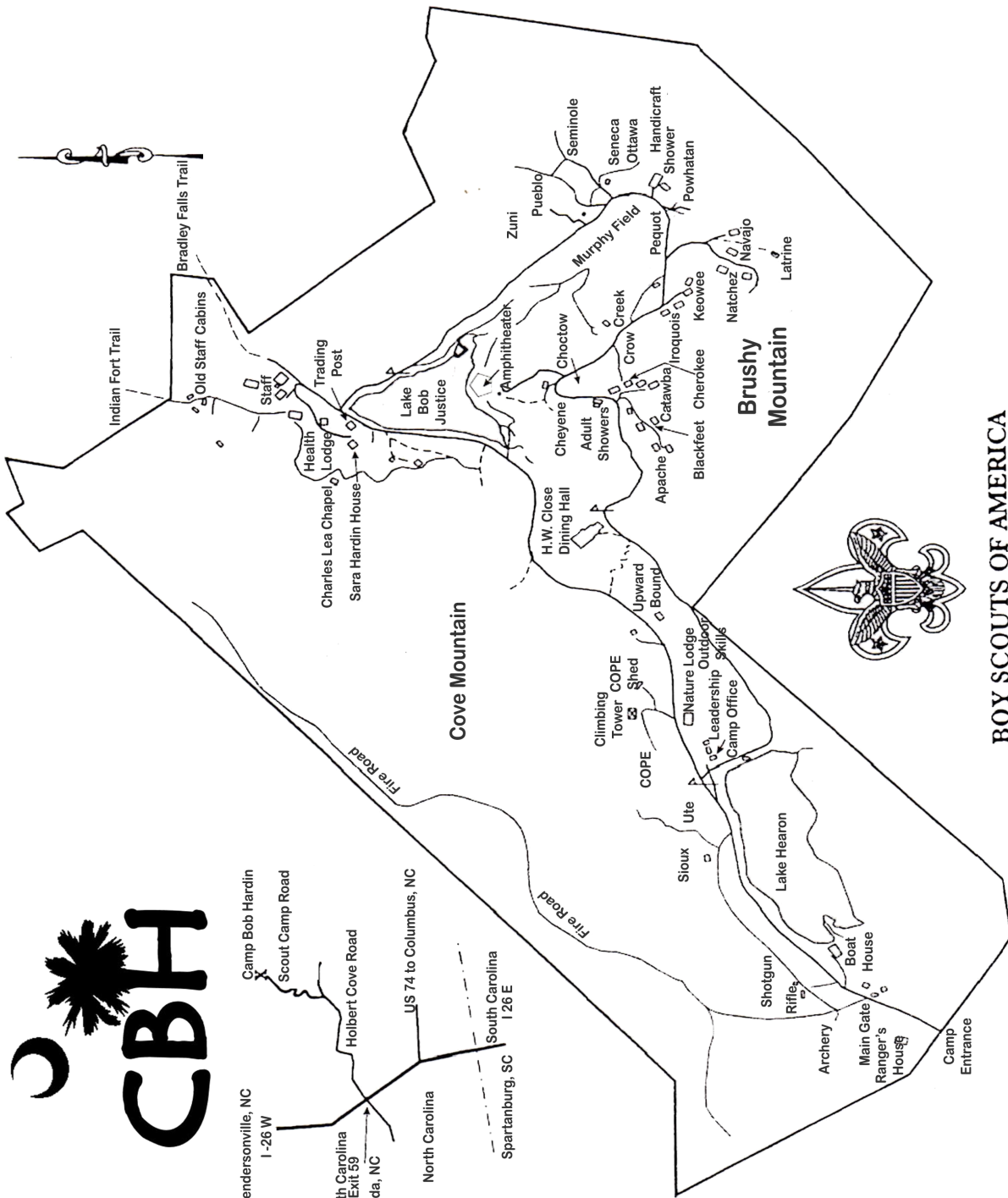
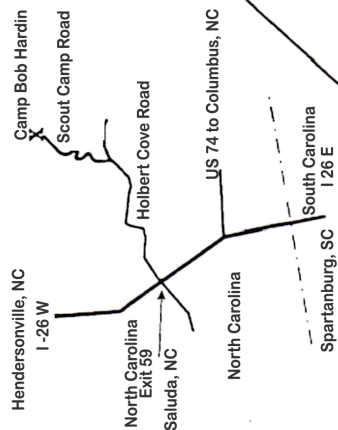
