











LION: Lion is a national pilot program of the Boy Scouts of America for kindergarten-age boys. The mission of the Boy Scouts of America is to help young people build character, learn citizenship, develop personal fitness, become effective leaders, and have fun in the outdoors. Cub Scouting is a program of the Boy Scouts of America for boys in the first through fifth grades. The Lion pilot is exploring the value of a Scouting program for kindergarten-age boys. (Boys must be 5 years old by September 1.)

**OVERVIEW:** Lion is a family-oriented program. A youth and his parent or caring adult partner join Scouting together. A group of six to eight boys and their adult partners meet together in a group called a den. Dens will meet approximately twice per month. They have fun participating in den meetings and outings while making memories together.

**PROGRAM:** The Lion pilot encourages boys to learn and explore through hands-on, highenergy activities. Adult partners take turns leading a den meeting or outing during the year. Most meetings last approximately 45 minutes to an hour; outings are slightly longer.

**RECOGNITIONS:** Boys are recognized for their accomplishments as they work toward the Lion badge. The Lion badge is earned by completing five adventures. Adventures are completed during the den meetings and outings. When an adventure is completed, the youth receives a sticker to put in his Lion Adventure Book.

**LEADERSHIP:** Den meetings and outings are facilitated by a Lion guide and participating parents. The Lion guide is an experienced Cub Scout leader. He or she will lead the first den meeting of the year. The Lion guide will help each adult partner lead one of the remaining meetings. The den meeting plans are provided in the Lion Parent and Leader Guidebook.

The Palmetto Council has been approved as a pilot council for the Lions Program. The council will be approving units to patriciate in the pilot program. If your unit wishes to apply, please visit www.palmettocouncil.org/lions.

# **PLANNING & BUDGET**

- DEVELOPING YOUR PROGRAM: Hold a brainstorming session with your youth and make a list of activities. Include a wide range of activities like field trips, campouts, and service projects. At this point, everything goes on the board-no evaluation happens.
- EVALUATE: The unit committee evaluates each suggestion and presents an "approved" list to the unit.
- DRAFT THE PLAN: Put together a draft of your annual program calendar. Then finalize the plan with a budget to support those events; sharing this information with the youth and families so they can plan their schedule around unit events. Be sure to use the district and council calendar to help assist your planning.

### WHAT JOURNEY TO EXCELLENCE BRINGS TO YOUR UNIT

- A FRAMEWORK FOR PLANNING: Journey to Excellence (JTE) standards are based on what successful units do to continually improve. If your unit plans to achieve Gold or Silver ranking, you'll have a strong and active program.
- A METHOD FOR EVALUATION YOUR UNIT: JTE provides tangible measurements based on things you are likely already tracking, such as how many campouts you have, how many youth are advancing, etc., and uses simple ways to calculate your performance.
- GUIDANCE: As you track your performance against JTE standards, you can easily see where you could do better.
- EARLY WARNINGS: You track any area where your unit is not performing as you might like and have plenty of time to make corrections.

### FUNDING THE ADVENTURE

So you've got a great program plan in place...but now how are you going to pay for it? To get started download the Pack/Troop budget planner at www.palmettocouncil.org/program-kickoff . Here are three steps for a successful fundraising campaign.

- Establish an annual plan and budget using the Pack/Troop Budget Planner.
- Determine the expenses from all activities, advancements, camping and training your unit wants to do, then decide how much popcorn your unit must sell to cover the expenses.
- 3. Set a unit fundraising goal and break down to a per-Scout-goal based on your budget

# **BSA FORMS & DATA**

During the course of each year, units will recruit new boys, train new leaders, have boys advance, and provide community service. Listed below are resources so that you can report your unit's information.

- ADVANCEMENT: Advancement records can be updated two ways. You can either turn in an Advancement Report OR you can link your unit's scoutbook/packmaster/troopmaster software to report the data using your Unit ID via Internet Advancement. To learn how to use your Unit ID, contact the Council Registrar. Regardless of how you report the data, you will need to provide a copy of the report when purchasing your advancements.
- SERVICE HOURS: Service Hours can be recorded online at servicehours.scouting.org OR via your My.Scouting.org account. To record hours, you will need your Unit ID to establish an account. To find your ID, contact the Council Registrar.
- ADULT TRAINING: Using my.scouting.org, unit Key 3's can track the training for their unit. To update your records, contact your respective District Executive.


