## CARE INSTRUCTIONS FOR YOUR SWEDISH FINISH FLOORS

You may walk carefully (stocking feet) on your Swedish Finished floor twelve (12) to fourteen (14) hours after the treatment, but do not use it regularly until twenty-four (24) to forty-eight (48) hours have elapsed depending on drying conditions (temperature and air humidity).

During the first forty-eight (48) hours do not move furniture. Wait ten (10) to fourteen (14) days before replacing area rugs. During first three (3) to four (4) weeks the floor should not be washed only vacuum cleaned or swept with a soft broom. **NEVER WAX! NEVER USE MURPHY'S OIL SOAP!** 

The daily cleaning is extremely simple and can be done with a vacuum cleaner, dust mop, or a slightly moistened cloth. Always go over dampened or washed areas with a dry fluffy towel. **NEVER WET MOP A WOOD FLOOR!** If you have build-up of greasy substance on a kitchen or bath area you may use one (1) cup of white vinegar to one (1) gallon of warm water for cleaning purposes, we also recommend **WOODWISE CLEANER** which can be purchased at most QFC grocery stores.. Avoid too frequent washing as well as the use of stiff brushes. **Do not use cleaning fluids.** 

Use a doormat at entries to prevent damage from sand and gravel on the ground floor. It is advisable to glue small pieces of felt, or use floor protector pads made specifically to prevent scratching, underneath the legs of chairs, or tables which are often moved. In offices and public premises, mats under the desks will protect the Swedish Finished floor from concentrated wear.
