# **BUSING**

The Racine Unified Transportation Office coordinates all of St. Catherine's busing needs. St. Catherine's will provide the transportation office with a complete listing of students enrolled for 2014-2015. Since we do not control busing, we suggest that parents contact the Transportation Department directly if they have questions or concerns. The Transportation Office phone number is (262)631-7138 and then choose option #1 in the automated menu.

**Important note for middle school busing** – Busing is <u>not</u> automatically assigned for middle school students. Busing is available for students based on bus routes of the high school. No new stops will be created for an individual middle school student. To be considered for busing, complete the enclosed "Alternate Transportation Form" and submit to the busing department by July 1. There is an annual fee attached to middle school busing only (**not** high school). This is out of St. Catherine's realm of influence. # SCHOOL SUPPLIES

### **UNIFORMS**

#### What is the school dress code?

**Tops:** Tops must be purchased from Lands' End, which include the Dominican shield embroidered on the left breast. To view approved school uniform selections, go to the Lands' End website: www.landsend.com. Click on the "School Uniform" tab and then "Find Your School's Dress Code".

Black, White, or Maize polo shirts (short and long-sleeved) with school logo embroidered on left breast. Only white short-sleeved undershirts may be worn under polo shirts. White blouses/oxford shirts may be worn with school logo embroidered on left breast. Sweaters, cardigans, or fleece warm-weather apparel must be solid white maize or black. No hooded warm-weather apparel allowed.

**Bottoms:** Khaki or Black uniform-style pants, capris, shorts, and skorts only. Black or brown belts may be worn. Skorts or shorts that are shorter than mid-thigh are not allowed. Pants, skorts, shorts and capris that are excessively tight fitting are not allowed. Cargo, carpenter, or yoga pants are not allowed. Though it is recommended to order uniform-style pants through Lands' End, it is not required.

**Shoes & Foot Apparel:** White or black socks are recommended. Any color shoes, sandals, or boots are allowed. Flip-flops, sliders or slippers are not allowed.
