- A typed, double-spaced essay describing why you are the best applicant to receive this scholarship. Why would the Heegeman family be proud to name you the recipient over all other students?
- Character Reference: Please submit one letter of recommendation from a non-relative adult (ex: teacher, coach, counselor, administrator, priest, employer, mentor, etc.). This may be no longer than one typed page.
- A transcript through the seventh semester of high school, showing courses attempted, grades earned and cumulative GPA.
