Amalie is a passionate designer and writer committed to achieving positive change through good design. As a landscape architect, urban designer and architect she brings a broad perspective to public realm projects. Over the past sixteen years she has worked across many project types and scales, ranging from bespoke public art and furniture, to residential developments and parklands, resort hotels, commercial precincts and transport infrastructure, both locally and abroad.

In 2007, Amalie was awarded the MECU Travel Bursary by Queensland University of Technology's Centre for Subtropical Design, enabling her to study the changing role of city parks in Colombia and the United States. She has since been commissioned by CSIRO Publishing to further develop her parkland studies in a book, due for release this September.

In 2012 Amalie founded Landscapology to utilise her unique skills and experience, and love of working with landscape, to create bespoke design solutions for curious and passionate people.
