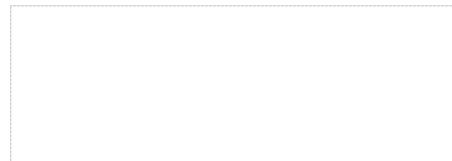
Introducing Our New **Contact Card**
