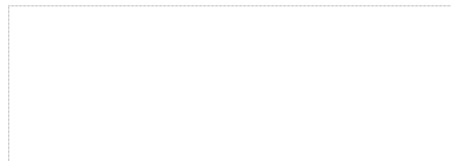
Senior S.N.A.C.

Alex Jones

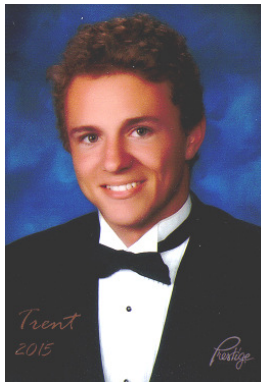
Alex Jones will graduate May 21, 2015 from Hamilton High School with an advanced diploma in the honors program.
