Using Google maps as a starting point, re-create your map section only using only typography.

Digital project

To create an A5 map of 1 area of London using Illustrator and only typography

You will be allocated 1 piece of the London map per pair

All pieces will then be pasted together throughout the session to piece together the full map

You must work with the rest of the group to make sure your map matches up from edge to edge. The map should be visually interesting but also informative


Aims

- Working in a team you will need to work with the other members of the group whose sections match up with yours


Constraints


- Section size A5
