Family Snapshot and Quality Review, next month

Support for 8th grade exmissions:

How can we support families better- attendance- after how many late/absences are families notified?

Now-send an email, call, majority don't tell until next day

Teacher takes attendance, considered late if in after 8:30, if late go to main office and sign in late book, get late pass. End of week, Tatiana scans attendance- first she looks at late book; if at Dr.- late, but excused. If you make corrections during that school year, it can be changed. If not notified until the next year, it cannot be changed.

7th grade blast- about attendance

Sometimes parents of older children may not know the kids are late

Look into other middle schools to see what they are doing

Teachers are not updating Ilearn as quickly as they should; sometimes it's too close to the end of the marking period and parents aren't aware there is a problem- and they can't help their children before the end of the marking period.

Discussion of Inclusion Program at MSC

Parent visitors presented synopsis of issues

Tatiana and Claire explain that discussion needs to be broad and should not be around individual students

Involved discussion took place around following issues: inclusion vs. general education; History of initial inclusion program at MSC; how all children can be supported, regardless of if they have IEP; whether all children are receiving a FAPE; better communication to parents, promotional criteria; creating positive learning environment for all children; etc.

Claire stated that she has met, and is available to meet, with parents to discuss their individual child's needs.
