Description: Mid-Minnesota Legal Aid (Legal Aid) is a 5-office, 60-attorney program providing the full range of civil legal services free to low-income Minnesotans, including elderly persons and persons with disabilities. Through 3 main offices located in Minneapolis, St. Cloud, and Willmar, Legal Aid provides services to 20 counties in Central Minnesota, including Hennepin County, and serves people with disabilities throughout the state through its Minnesota Disability Law Center.

Legal Aid-St. Cloud: This office is located in downtown St. Cloud and serves eligible clients in the surrounding nine counties. The law clerk will provide support to the office's Immigration Law Project with a focus on assisting clients seeking renewal of Deferred Action Status. St. Cloud's Immigration Law Project provides services ranging from helping Somali immigrants get green cards to helping young Hispanic and Latino immigrants brought to the United States by their parents as children, get Deferred Action Status, allowing them to remain in the United States without fear of deportation and to get work documents. If time allows, the clerk will also have the opportunity to work with Legal Aid's Health Care Outreach Project, an innovative program helping low-income people get health insurance. Experience/Education Requirements: The position is open to law students. Applicants should also have a demonstrated interest in and commitment to the needs of low-income/vulnerable clients, as well as excellent communication, analytical, and writing skills. Consideration will be given to the applicant's relevant course work and/or legal clinic experiences. Spanish language ability strongly preferred. Diverse economic, social, or cultural experiences and relevant language skills are a plus.
