## Savor authentic Danish cuisine

There's nothing like an open-faced sandwich. Stroll down to the ELK **HORN TOWN HALL** on Saturday where you'll find true Danish openfaced sandwiches or smørrebrød (buttered bread). These sandwiches are works of art on a slice of bread. The Danes use a knife and fork to eat them. Open-faced sandwiches consist of a single slice of bread (usually rye bread) topped with fine meat or cheese. Openfaced sandwiches prepared for Tivoli Fest are Reje Salat (Shrimp Salad), Rullepølse (Beef with spices), Lakse Salat (Salmon Salad), Marineret Sild (Pickled Herring), Leverpostei (Liver Pate), Skinke (Ham), Bøf med Remoulade (Roast Beef), Flæskesteg (Roast Pork), Havarti Ost (Havarti Cheese), Æg og Ansjos (Egg with Anchovies) with all the trimmings. For dessert, enjoy a piece of Danish layer cake or æblekage (apple cake).

#### At the **NEW ELK HORN FIRE STATION** (both Saturday and Sunday), enjoy watching the cooks use special æbleskiver pans and knitting needles to make these unique, round Danish entree treats served with syrup, jelly or sugar. Also served is medisterpølse, a Danish seasoned sausage, to make a complete, hearty meal.

Tivoli Fest Opening Ceremonies will be held at the Danish Windmill at 8 a.m. on Saturday, May 23. With the help of the local Color Guard, the Tivoli King and Queen will raise the Danish and American flags to the strains of the U.S. and Danish national anthems. Mayor Stan Jens, and the Tivoli chairperson Dustin Petersen, will conduct the ceremonies.

The Mill to Mermaid Fun Run/Walk will begin at 8:15 a.m. immediately following the opening ceremonies. The M & M run will end in Kimballton at the Little Mermaid fountain in the City Park with T-shirts given to the winners in each age division. Juice and M&Ms will be available for all participants. All ages are welcome. Registration is from 7:30-8 a.m., at the former Danish Inn Restaurant, and closes just prior to the run. The fee is \$5 per person for ages 12 and older. The Tivoli Fest Fireworks Spectacular can be seen from the Windmill grounds. Fireworks have been a part of the Tivoli Gardens in Copenhagen, Denmark, for over 150 years. The only exception was during WWII. Elk Horn is excited to carry on this tradition with their annual fireworks extravaganza by the Waymire Brothers. The aerial display will begin on Saturday night after dark on the southeast side of the Tivoli Inn & Suites Motel. The public is invited to sit on the grass south of the motel or on the Windmill grounds. Major funding for the fireworks display is provided by local businesses and generous donations from the public. Mange Tak! 

Few people know as much about the diverse Norsemen as they think. Along with their spoken demos and the steel combat, they also sport an accurate Viking camp complete with tents, cook pots and wares, furs, and other details.


