

WHAT CAN WE EXPECT FROM GOD?

1. Freedom from Addictions

And call upon me in the day of trouble: I will deliver you, and you shalt glorify me.

- Psalms 50:15

Is not this the fast that I have chosen? to loose the bands of wickedness, to undo the heavy burdens, and to let the oppressed go free, and that you break every yoke?

- Isaiah 58:6

The Spirit of the Lord GOD is upon me; because the LORD has anointed me to preach good tidings unto the meek; he has sent me to bind up the brokenhearted, to proclaim liberty to the captives, and the opening of the prison to them that are bound;

- Isaiah 61:1

If the Son therefore shall make you free, you shall be free indeed.

- John 8:36

There is therefore now no condemnation to them which are in Christ Jesus, who walk not after the flesh, but after the Spirit. For the law of the Spirit of life in Christ Jesus has made me free from the law of sin and death.

- Romans 8:1-2

There has no temptation taken you but such as is common to man: but God is faithful, who will not suffer you to be tempted above that you are able; but with every temptation also make a way to escape, that you may be able to bear it.

- 1 Corinthians 10:13

Therefore if any man be in Christ, he is a new creature: old things are passed away; behold, all things are become new.

- 2 Corinthians 5:17

This I say then, Walk in the Spirit, and you shall not fulfill the lust of the flesh.

2. Deliverance from Demonic Harassment

The angel of the LORD encamps round about them that fear him, and delivers them.

- Psalms 34:7

For You have been a shelter for me, and a strong tower from the enemy.

- Psalms 61:3

Because he hath set his love upon me, therefore will I deliver him: I will set him on high, because he has known my name. He shall call upon me, and I will answer him: I will be with him in trouble; I will deliver him, and honor him.

- Psalms 91:14-15

And Jesus rebuked the devil; and he departed out of him: and the child was cured from that very hour. Then came the disciples to Jesus apart, and said, Why could not we cast him out? And Jesus said unto them, Because of your unbelief: for verily I say unto you, If you have faith as a grain of mustard seed, you shall say unto this mountain, Remove hence to yonder place; and it shall remove; and nothing shall be impossible unto you. Howbeit this kind goes not out but by prayer and fasting.

And Jesus returned in the power of the Spirit into Galilee: and there went out a fame of him through all the region round about. And he taught in their synagogues, being glorified of all. And he came to Nazareth, where he had been brought up: and, as his custom was, he went into the synagogue on the Sabbath day, and stood up for to read. And there was delivered unto him the book of the prophet Isaiah. And when he had opened the book, he found the place where it was written, The Spirit of the Lord is upon me, because he has anointed me to preach the gospel to the poor; he has sent me to heal the brokenhearted, to preach deliverance to the captives, and recovering of sight to the blind, to set at liberty them that are oppressed.

Submit yourselves therefore to God. Resist the devil, and he will flee from you.

And I heard a loud voice saying in heaven, Now is come salvation, and strength, and the kingdom of our God, and the power of his Christ: for the accuser of our brethren is cast down, which accused them before our God day and night. And they overcame him by the blood of the Lamb, and by the word of their testimony; and they loved not their lives unto the death.

3. Freedom from Depression

The LORD also will be a refuge for the oppressed, a refuge in times of trouble. And they that know thy name will put their trust in you: for thou, LORD, has not forsaken them that seek you.

The righteous cry, and the LORD hears, and delivers them out of all their troubles.

- **Psalms 34:17**

Then they cried unto the LORD in their trouble, and he saved them out of their distresses. He brought them out of darkness and the shadow of death, and broke their bands in two. Oh that men would praise the LORD for his goodness, and for his wonderful works to the

children of men! For he has broken the gates of brass, and cut the bars of iron in sunder.

- Psalms 107:13-16

Heaviness in the heart of man makes it stoop: but a good word makes it glad.

- Proverbs 12:25

Fear not; for I am with thee: be not dismayed; for I am your God: I will strengthen you; yes, I will help you; yes, I will uphold you with the right hand of my righteousness.

- Isaiah 41:10

For the mountains shall depart, and the hills be removed; but my kindness shall not depart from you, neither shall the covenant of my peace be removed, says the LORD that has mercy on you.

- Isaiah 54:10

Remembering my affliction and my misery, the wormwood and the gall. My soul has them still in remembrance, and is humbled in me. This I recall to my mind, therefore have I hope. It is of the LORD's mercies that we are not consumed, because his compassions fail not. They are new every morning: great is your faithfulness. The LORD is my portion, says my soul; therefore will I hope in him. The LORD is good to them that wait for him, to the soul that seeks him.

Grace be to you and peace from God our Father, and from the Lord Jesus Christ. Blessed be God, even the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of mercies, and the God of all comfort; Who comforts us in all our tribulation, that we may be able to comfort them which are in any trouble, by the comfort with which we ourselves are comforted of God.

- 2 Corinthians 1:2-4

4. Family Blessing

Honor your father and thy mother: that thy days may be long upon the land which the LORD thy God gives you.

But the mercy of the LORD is from everlasting to everlasting upon them that fear him, and his righteousness unto children's children.

Train up a child in the way he should go: and when he is old, he will not depart from it.

- Proverbs 22:6

The father of the righteous shall greatly rejoice: and he that begets a wise child shall have joy of him.

- Proverbs 23:24

For I will pour water upon him that is thirsty, and floods upon the dry ground: I will pour my spirit upon thy seed, and my blessing upon your offspring:

- Isaiah 44:3

But thus says the LORD, Even the captives of the mighty shall be taken away, and the prey of the terrible shall be delivered: for I will contend with him that contends with thee, and I will save your children.

And he shall turn the heart of the fathers to the children, and the heart of the children to their fathers...

5. Freedom from Fear

The LORD shall fight for you, and you shall hold your peace.

- Exodus 14:14

And the LORD, he it is that goes before you; he will be with you, he will not fail you, neither forsake you: fear not, neither be dismayed.

- Deuteronomy 31:8

Have not I commanded you? Be strong and of a good courage; be not afraid, neither be dismayed: for the LORD your God is with you wherever you go.

- Joshua 1:9

I will call upon the LORD, who is worthy to be praised: so shall I be saved from my enemies.

- Psalms 18:3

Yea, though I walk through the valley of the shadow of death, I will fear no evil: for you are with me; your rod and your staff they comfort me.

- Psalms 23:4

The LORD is my light and my salvation; whom shall I fear? the LORD is the strength of my life; of whom shall I be afraid?

- Psalms 27:1

The angel of the LORD encamps round about them that fear him, and delivers them.

- Psalms 34:7

For you have been a shelter for me, and a strong tower from the enemy.

- Psalms 61:3

For I the LORD your God will hold your right hand, saying unto you, Fear not; I will help you.

- Isaiah 41:13

When you pass through the waters, I will be with you; and through the rivers, they shall not overflow you: when thou walk through the fire, you shalt not be burned; neither shall the flame kindle upon you.

- Isaiah 43:2

Peace I leave with you, my peace I give unto you: not as the world gives, give I to you. Let not your heart be troubled, neither let it be afraid.

6. Filling of Holy Spirit

Turn you at my reproof: behold, I will pour out my spirit unto you, I will make known my words unto you.

- Proverbs 1:23

For I will pour water upon him that is thirsty, and floods upon the dry ground: I will pour my spirit upon your seed, and my blessing upon your offspring:

- Isaiah 44:3

And I say unto you, Ask, and it shall be given you; seek, and ye shall find; knock, and it shall be opened unto you. For every one that asks receives; and he that seeks finds; and to him that knocks it shall be opened. If a son shall ask bread of any of you that is a father, will he give him a stone? or if he ask a fish, will he for a fish give him a serpent? Or if he shall ask an egg, will he offer him a scorpion? If ye then, being evil, know how to give good gifts unto your children: how much more shall your heavenly Father give the Holy Spirit to them that ask him?

- Luke 11:9-13

And whatsoever you shall ask in my name, that will I do, that the Father may be glorified in the Son. If you shall ask anything in my name, I will do it. If you love me, keep my commandments. And I will pray the Father, and he shall give you another Comforter, that he may abide with you forever;

- John 14:13-16

But you shall receive power, after that the Holy Ghost is come upon you: and ye shall be witnesses unto me both in Jerusalem, and in all Judaea, and in Samaria, and unto the uttermost part of the earth.

- Acts 1:8

And it shall come to pass in the last days, says God, I will pour out of my Spirit upon all flesh: and your sons and your daughters shall prophesy, and your young men shall see visions, and your old men shall dream dreams: And on my servants and on my handmaidens I will pour out in those days of my Spirit; and they shall prophesy:

- Acts 2:17-18

Then Peter said unto them, Repent, and be baptized every one of you in the name of Jesus Christ for the remission of sins, and ye shall receive the gift of the Holy Ghost. For the

promise is unto you, and to your children, and to all that are afar off, even as many as the LORD our God shall call.

- Acts 2:38-39

That he would grant you, according to the riches of his glory, to be strengthened with might by his Spirit in the inner man; That Christ may dwell in your hearts by faith; that you, being rooted and grounded in love, May be able to comprehend with all saints what is the breadth, and length, and depth, and height; And to know the love of Christ, which passes knowledge, that you might be filled with all the fullness of God.

7. Adequate Financial Blessing & Jobs

The LORD shall open unto you his good treasure, the heaven to give the rain unto your land in his season, and to bless all the work of your hand: and you shall lend unto many nations, and shall not borrow.

- Deuteronomy 28:12

He becomes poor that deals with a slack hand: but the hand of the diligent makes rich.

- Proverbs 10:4

Wealth gotten by vanity shall be diminished: but he that gathers by labor shall increase.

- Proverbs 13:11

Bring all the tithes into the storehouse, that there may be meat in mine house, and prove me now herewith, says the LORD of hosts, if I will not open for you the windows of heaven, and pour you out a blessing, that there shall not be room enough to receive it.

- Malachi 3:10

Therefore take no thought, saying, What shall we eat? or, What shall we drink? or, With what shall we be clothed? (For after all these things do the Gentiles seek:) for your heavenly Father knows that you have need of all these things. But seek first the kingdom of God, and his righteousness; and all these things shall be added unto you.

- Matthew 6:31-33

But my God shall supply all your needs according to his riches in glory by Christ Jesus.

- Philippians 4:19

8. God's Guidance

And, behold, I am with you, and will keep you in all places wherever you go, and will bring you again into this land; for I will not leave you, until I have done that which I have spoken to you.

- Genesis 28:15

What man is he that fears the LORD? him shall he teach in the way that he shall choose.

- Psalms 25:12

I will instruct you and teach you in the way which you shall go: I will guide you with my eye.

- Psalms 32:8

Trust in the LORD with all you heart; and lean not on your own understanding. In all your ways acknowledge him, and he shall direct your paths.

- Proverbs 3:5-6

And if you draw out your soul to the hungry, and satisfy the afflicted soul; then shall your light rise in obscurity, and your darkness be as the noon day: And the LORD shall guide you continually, and satisfy your soul in drought, and make fat your bones: and you shall be like a watered garden, and like a spring of water, whose waters fail not.

- Isaiah 58:10-11

And it shall come to pass, that before they call, I will answer; and while they are yet speaking, I will hear.

- Isaiah 65:24

Call unto me, and I will answer you, and show you great and mighty things, which you know not.

- Jeremiah 33:3

Howbeit when he, the Spirit of truth, is come, he will guide you into all truth: for he shall not speak of his own volition; but whatever he shall hear, that shall he speak: and he will show you things to come.

- John 16:13

If any of you lack wisdom, let him ask of God, that gives to all men liberally without reproach and it shall be given him.

9. Health

And said, If you will diligently hearken to the voice of the LORD your God, and will do that which is right in his sight, and will give ear to his commandments, and keep all his statutes, I will put none of these diseases upon you, which I have brought upon the Egyptians: for I am the LORD that heals thee.

- Exodus 15:26

Bless the LORD, O my soul, and forget not all his benefits: Who forgives all your iniquities; who heals all your diseases; Who redeems your life from destruction; who crowns you with lovingkindness and tender mercies; Who satisfies your mouth with good things; so that your youth is renewed like the eagle's.

- Psalms 103:2-5

Be not wise in your own eyes: fear the LORD, and depart from evil. It shall be health to thy navel, and marrow to thy bones.

- Proverbs 3:7-8

But they that wait upon the LORD shall renew their strength; they shall mount up with wings as eagles; they shall run, and not be weary; and they shall walk, and not faint.

- Isaiah 40:31

He is despised and rejected of men; a man of sorrows, and acquainted with grief: and we hid as it were our faces from him; he was despised, and we esteemed him not. Surely he has borne our griefs, and carried our sorrows: yet we did esteem him stricken, smitten of God, and afflicted. But he was wounded for our transgressions, he was bruised for our iniquities: the chastisement of our peace was upon him; and with his stripes we are healed.

- Isaiah 53:3-5

Heal me, O LORD, and I shall be healed; save me, and I shall be saved: for you are my praise.

- Jeremiah 17:14

For I will restore health unto you, and I will heal you of thy wounds, says the LORD...

- Jeremiah 30:17

But unto you that fear my name shall the Sun of righteousness arise with healing in his wings; and you shall go forth, and grow up as calves of the stall.

- Malachi 4:2

Is any sick among you? let him call for the elders of the church; and let them pray over him, anointing him with oil in the name of the Lord: And the prayer of faith shall save the sick, and the Lord shall raise him up; and if he has committed sins, they shall be forgiven him.

- James 5:14-15

10 A Great Marriage/Companionship

And the LORD God said, It is not good that the man should be alone; I will make him an help meet for him.

- Genesis 2:18

Delight thyself also in the LORD: and he shall give you the desires of your heart.

God sets the solitary in families...

Whoever finds a wife finds a good thing, and obtains favor of the LORD.

- Proverbs 18:22

For your Maker is your husband; the LORD of hosts is his name; and thy Redeemer the Holy One of Israel; The God of the whole earth shall he be called.

- Isaiah 54:5

For I know the thoughts that I think toward you, says the LORD, thoughts of peace, and not of evil, to give you an expected end.

- Jeremiah 29:11

And this is the confidence that we have in him, that, if we ask any thing according to his will, he hears us:

11. Eternal Salvation & Forgiveness of Sins

I have blotted out, as a thick cloud, your transgressions, and, as a cloud, your sins: return unto me; for I have redeemed you.

- Isaiah 44:22

And I will deliver you out of the hand of the wicked, and I will redeem you out of the hand of the terrible.

- Jeremiah 15:21

For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believes in him should not perish, but have everlasting life.

- John 3:16

He that believes on the Son has everlasting life: and he that believes not the Son shall not see life; but the wrath of God abides on him.

- John 3:36

For the wages of sin is death; but the gift of God is eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord.

- Romans 6:23

For I am persuaded, that neither death, nor life, nor angels, nor principalities, nor powers, nor things present, nor things to come, Nor height, nor depth, nor any other creature, shall be able to separate us from the love of God, which is in Christ Jesus our Lord.

- Romans 8:38-39

That if you shall confess with your mouth the Lord Jesus, and shalt believe in your heart that God hath raised him from the dead, you shalt be saved. For with the heart man believeth unto righteousness; and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation.

- Romans 10:9-10

To the praise of the glory of his grace, wherein he has made us accepted in the beloved. In whom we have redemption through his blood, the forgiveness of sins, according to the riches of his grace;

12. Strength to do God's will

Have not I commanded you? Be strong and of a good courage; be not afraid, neither be dismayed: for the LORD thy God is with you wherever you go.

- Joshua 1:9

Wait on the LORD: be of good courage, and he shall strengthen your heart: wait, I say, on the LORD.

- Psalms 27:14

He gives power to the faint; and to them that have no might he increases strength.

- Isaiah 40:29

No weapon that is formed against you shall prosper; and every tongue that shall rise against you in judgment you shall condemn. This is the heritage of the servants of the LORD, and their righteousness is of me, says the LORD.

- Isaiah 54:17

For which cause we faint not; but though our outward man perish, yet the inward man is renewed day by day. For our light affliction, which is but for a moment, works for us a far more exceeding and eternal weight of glory; While we look not at the things which are seen, but at the things which are not seen: for the things which are seen are temporal; but the things which are not seen are eternal.

- 2 Corinthians 4:16-18

And let us not be weary in well doing: for in due season we shall reap, if we faint not.

- Galatians 6:9

I can do all things through Christ which strengthens me.

- Philippians 4:13
