

Chelsea Flower Show 11 – 24 May 2015

Day 1 – 11 May D

London

On arrival into London Heathrow or London Gatwick Airport meet your driver for the transfer to your hotel, where you will check in. The remainder of the day will be at leisure, to relax or explore the city independently. Dinner will be at the hotel.

Day 2 – 12 May B,D

London

Take breakfast in the hotel, before meeting your driver and guide for a full day sightseeing tour of this exciting city. Throughout the morning enjoy a panoramic tour, with photo stops including Buckingham Palace, Westminster Abbey, the Houses of Parliament, Trafalgar Square and the Tower of London. Have some free time for lunch at leisure, before continuing your tour with a



'flight' on the EDF Energy London Eye. Experience spectacular views across the capital as you take in a bird's eye view of your surroundings!

Return to your hotel for an evening of leisure. Dinner will be at the hotel.

Day 3 – 13 May B,D

London - Bath

Check out of your hotel after an early breakfast, and depart the hotel to begin your tour of England. Day 4 – 14 May B,D

Bath-Bristol-Bath

Head to Bristol this morning to discover this city's history. Bristol was historically an important trading port, however the city is also known for its involvement with the slave trade throughout the centuries. Many buildings in the city centre are the result of the economic boom experienced during the height of the slave trade! Today, Bristol is a beautiful city and home to such sights as the SS Great Britain (the world's first



great ocean liner) and the Clifton Suspension Bridge. Spend the morning in Bristol and enjoy time for lunch before heading to Lacock Abbey. A former monastery (and filming location for Harry Potter!), Lacock Abbey also has a botanic garden, orchard and rose garden to explore. Spend some time wandering around these relaxed gardens, before heading back to Bath for the evening. Dinner at the hotel.

Day 5 – 15 May

Bath-Oxford-Stratford

Continue your journey this morning as you travel to the university city of Oxford. Steeped in history, the stunning buildings of Oxford, parks, university colleges and river make for an enchanting morning as you wander the streets at leisure and enjoy lunch in one of the many cafes and restaurants. After lunch you will travel to Stratford-upon-Avon, home of William Shakespeare. On arrival, visit his birthplace before checking in to your hotel. Day 6 – 16 May B,D

Stratford-Manchester

Head north from the Midlands to the city of Manchester. This 'behind the scenes' tour is sure to interest everyone – even if you are not a football fan! After the tour, you head to the fashionable Salford Quays district, where your hotel is located. Dinner will be at the hotel.

Day 7 – 17 May B,D

Manchester-York-Sheffield

Head through the Pennines Mountains this morning – often termed the backbone of England – to the Viking city of York. Home of exquisite architecture, quaint cobbled streets and the largest gothic cathedral in northern Europe, people from all over the world fall in love with York! Visit York Minster cathedral, before taking an optional visit to the Jorvik Viking Centre – a fabulous attraction that details the Viking attacks and



influence over the city. Discover artefacts and centuries old buildings! Optional visit to Jorvik Viking Centre – price not included.

From York you begin to journey south again, stopping in the city of Sheffield for the night. Dinner will be at the hotel.

Day 8 – 18 May B,D

Sheffield-Cambridge

This morning you will travel to Cambridge, home to one of the world's most famous universities. Famed for its rivalry with Oxford, you can decide for yourself which city captures your heart the most! Watch out for bicycles as you explore the city — thousands of people cycle around Cambridge daily and can cause as much chaos as the cars! During your time in the city you will visit the University Botanical Gardens, where you can



discover plants from all over the world in 40 acres of beautiful gardens and glasshouses. You will stay in Cambridge tonight, where dinner will be at the hotel.

Day 9 – 19 May B,D

Cambridge-London

Enjoy a free morning in Cambridge to stroll around the streets and maybe visit one or two of the university colleges (the larger colleges such as King's College and Queen's College will charge an entrance fee, but some of the smaller colleges are free to enter the grounds). After lunch at leisure, depart Cambridge to travel back to London. Check in to your hotel before taking dinner in a local restaurant.

Day 10 – 20 May

London

This morning you will visit Windsor Castle, said to be the Queen's favourite weekend residence. The castle is the oldest and largest inhabited castle in the world, and is home to one of the most important art collections. As well as the magnificent State Rooms, take time to visit St George's Chapel, a stunning ecclesiastical building and the final resting of numerous royalties, such as King Henry VIII, Jane Seymour, Charles I and Queen Elizabeth the Queen Mother.




In the afternoon, head back to London for an afternoon and evening at leisure. Dinner tonight will be taken independently.

Parts of the city are designated UNESCO World Heritage Sites. Spend the



morning here, with lunch at leisure. In the afternoon you will travel to Leeds Castle - rising from the still waters of the surrounding moat, and with 500 acres of parkland and gardens, Leeds Castle has a definite romantic air about it! Enjoy an afternoon here before returning to London for a farewell dinner. A fantastic end to your England tour.
