MSSRA Launches New Points Program for Most Active Member Award

The Most Active Member Award, MAMA, is presented each year to a member deemed the most active for that calendar year and is normally presented at the Christmas party.

The revised points system was reintroduced in 2012 with a significant change in that a member in good standing is given point's card at the beginning of the year and points are awarded by any elected officer or the event chair signing the card. The point's cards are turned in to the Board of Directors at the November General Membership meeting where the points are tabulated and the winner is announced at the Annual Christmas party. The winner will receive an award valued at not less than \$200 as determined by the Board of Directors and their name added to the Most Active Member plaque. Points are awarded based on the following:

7	Committee Chair – Any member who chairs membership, official photographer, newsletter, web master, Member-At-Large, or other committee appointed by the President will be awarded points at the end of the year.		
3	Volunteer - Any member who volunteers to assist with an event receive points based on four hours of duty.		
1	Meeting Attendance – Any member attending a monthly general membership meeting will be awarded one point at the end of the meeting.		
1	Thursday Night Cruise – Awarded point is based on the member meeting at the point of origin (Sears's parking log) and cruising to the destination. The member does not have to stay for dinner.		
1	Breakfast Bunch – Attending the weekly breakfast which is held in various locations.		
1	MSSRA Event - Points are awarded at the end of the event. 
