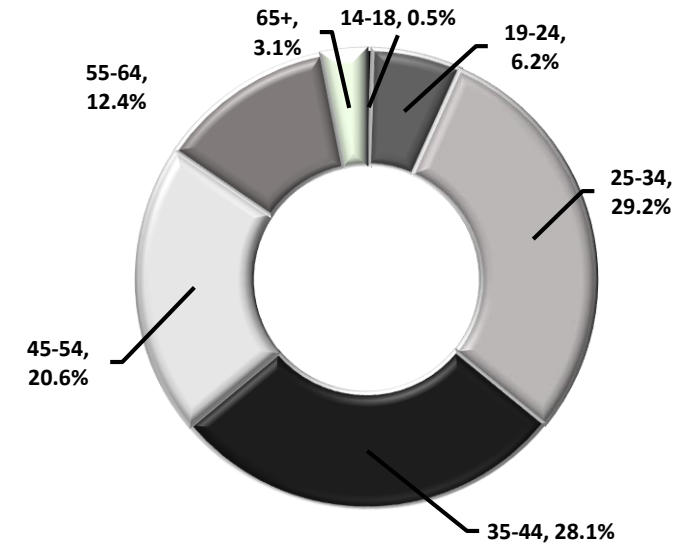

After the recession, recovery has been gradually building. Job numbers have already reached pre-recessions levels and have grown beyond, with continued growth projected over the next ten years.
