The 10th annual WINGS Luncheon, presented by Texas Health Resources and held April 12 at the Hyatt Regency Dallas, was an impressive event that raised awareness and more than \$480,000 for the women and children of New Friends New Life. Barbara Pierce Bush, CEO and co-founder of Global Health Corps, engaged the audience about her mission of drawing young leaders into the work of championing women's right and health equity. Ms. Bush stated that Global Health Corps volunteers stationed overseas report that the same resources invested in exploited women and trafficked girls in other countries are needed for victims in the United States. 
