## Directions:

- Give each person a BINGO card (these can be printed on cardstock or just plain paper
- 2. Each player should also receive some markers use colored pieces of paper, pennies, dried beans, or the plastic discs found in many other games
- 3. Print off and shuffle the clue cards, and stack them, clue side down
- 4. One person turns over the top card and reads the clue so all can hear.

  Don't give the answer immediately- see if anyone else knows the answer
- 5. Each player checks his or her card to see if the appropriate answer appears in one of the boxes. If it does, the square is covered with a marker.
- 6. This process continues until one player wins.

## To Win:

A player must cover the answer squares in one of the following ways:
