MASS PARTICIPATION

If you are not attending Mass with your children, it is almost impossible for us to help them form a relationship with Jesus. Please continue to pray with your children and ensure that they know the prayers appropriate for their age level. We encourage you to attend the sacrament of reconciliation with your children. Thus, your good example will lead them to value our faith in practice.

First Reconciliation and First Communion:

First Communion will be celebrated during the second semester of 2nd grade. First Reconciliation will precede First Communion. Parents must attend the 2 preparation classes offered in the parish. A First Communion Retreat will be scheduled for the spring.

Confirmation (10th Grade):

Our Youth Group Coordinator, Mike Zacek, plans this program for the 10th grade class. A weekend Confirmation Retreat is on the schedule. Sunday Adult Formation:

Adult education is available for those who wish to further their personal, spiritual and academic growth in their faith. The Sunday morning Adult Formation group meets from 9:00 a.m. to 10:10 a.m. during the Religious Education school year. Topics include Scripture, prayer, morality, current church teaching and literature. Professor Larry Dotolo of ODU facilitates the group.

Children's Liturgy of the Word:

There are two programs. One designed for children in Pre-K and Kindergarten, and one designed for children in Grade 1 through Grade 3. They take place on Sunday mornings. It is a wonderful way to help children understand the Word of God through stories and activities. Children leave the main church after the Opening Prayer and return during the offertory of the 10:30 a.m. Mass.

Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA):

This is a process whereby we welcome others to explore what it is to be a member of the Catholic community. The process is one of reflection on life experiences, Scripture, and teachings of the Catholic Church. The RCIA follows four distinct phases, during which the parish community supports each individual through prayer and fellowship. These four phases are celebrated through liturgies, informal meetings, prayerful reflection, and personal renewal.
