What is Flickr?

- Image / video hosting website.
- Online photographic community.
- Acquired by YAHOO! in 2005.
- As of March 2013, there were 87 million registered users and more than 3.5 million new images uploaded daily.
- In August 2011, the site reported hosting more than 6 billion images.

What is Flickr?

- A Flickr account is required to upload content.
 You can view content without an account.
- Account types:
 - Free: 1TB of storage, 200MB per photo, 1GB per video.
 - Ad-Free: Same as Free account with no ads.\$50/yr.
 - Doublr: 2TB of storage, same benefits as Free account, \$500/yr.

What is a Terabyte?

- Short answer: 1 trillion bytes.
- Equals approx. 1,048,000 megabytes.
- Will store approx. 500,000 photos a 6 megapixels.
- Personal account has 1,150 photos (full resolution) and only using 0.5% of 1TB.




Why Use Flickr?

How to Create an Account


- <u>flickr.com</u> and click "SIGN UP".
- Requires you to create Yahoo account/email address.
- Fill out form.





Photostream


- The only place your photos exist on Flickr is in your photostream.
- All photos get uploaded to the photostream.
- Sorts by newest photo first.



Albums


- Collection of images that is defined by the user.
- Can have unlimited number of albums

containing an unlimited number of photos.



Groups

- A group is a way to combine photos from many different Flickr accounts.
- Can be public or private groups.
- You can join any fick public group that interests
 you.
- Hundreds of thousands to choose from.




Groups

 Kawartha Camera Club has a Flickr group just for members.


Only members

- Search for the group you want.
- Click the Join button.



Joining a Group


- The Kawartha Camera Club group is invite only.
- Just fill in the message box with your name and hit "Send This".
- Ensures only members are part of the group.

Group Discussions

- Group discussions are a great way to interact with members of the same group.
- Every group usually has on-going discussions.
- Can also start you own discussion.



Sharing Photos

 You can share an individual photo directly to Facebook, Twitter, Email, or copy and paste a link.

 The email option uses your Yahoo account associated with Flickr.



Sharing Albums

 You can also share an entire album by sending the link to social media or through email.

 This is a good feature for club members who want to share photos from an event or outing.
