# **Planting**

Protect the roots of your tree from drying out or freezing, especially if you do not plan on planting soon after your purchase. Trim extra long or broken root, and, if the tree has an extensive root ball, loosen the sides and bottom to promote root expansion. Dig the hole 1.5 - 2 times the width of the root system, but only slightly deeper than their length. Mix 1 part Gold Rush or Dr. Earth Fruit Tree Planting Mix with 3 parts native soil. Add fertilizer to the soil, following the directions for new plantings on the back of the bag. Be sure that the bud union is not buried below the surface level to avoid trunk rot. Tamp the soil around the tree to eliminate air pockets. Creating a wide shallow basin around the tree can help to retain water. If the tree is not dormant, water thoroughly. Prune the top by 1/3 -1/2, removing all but 3 or 4 well spaced branches (our trees are pre-pruned); for more detailed pruning instructions we offer a fruit tree pruning seminar in January.

# **Feeding**

We recommend using Master Nursery Fruit Tree & Vine Food or Dr. Earth Fruit Tree Fertilizer. Ideally, three applications should be made per year, once in early February or when the trees begin to emerge from dormancy, another after the fruit has set, and once more immediately after harvest up to early Fall.
