Next week James Yardley will speak on The Gospel of Jesus' Wife. In September of 2012, Prof. Karen King of the Harvard Divinity School presented at an international conference her investigations of a newly-discovered ancient manuscript fragment, from a previously unknown Christian gospel. Her analysis of the text of this fragment provides the phrase "Jesus said to them, My wife....". This discovery has created much controversy. Consequently, a team of researchers at Columbia University and New York University has undertaken scientific examination of the ink of this fragment. James will summarize what is known about the fragment, describe the basic findings and other evidence relating to the authenticity of this fragment, and provide some speculation on the significance of this research to the history of Christianity.
