How to use Talk It Over:

Talking through the message during the week helps you and your group turn what God is saying to you into action steps. Begin with the key questions, add any optional scriptures and questions if needed, and then wrap up by deciding on your next steps.

The Main Idea:

- As we hear God's Word we are changed and our faith grows. As the church faithfully proclaims God's Word, our region is transformed by His power.

Key Questions:

- Last week, Brian explained that we are sent by God to be His agents of to share the Good News. How has that message resonated with you during this past week? Has it caused you to do anything differently? Have you sensed any barriers that you could be helping to eliminate?
- In the sermon, we heard that salvation is the ultimate answer to all of God's problems. How would you explain that statement or put it into your own words based on your understanding and experience?
- Calling on God has three components: 1) admitting we need help; 2) believing God can help; 3) doing what God tells us to do. How have those three things played out in your own journey of faith?
- The Bible teaches us about Jesus: Why He came, what He did, and what that means. Discuss what each of those three things are.
- McLane Church's first core value is "The power of the Word of God to change lives." Have you experienced that power in your own life? Share one aspect of how Scripture has changed your life.

Optional Questions:

- How has the move to video technology affected your experience in worship at McLane?
- The 8th core value of McLane Church is "A commitment to be inconvenienced for the sake of the Gospel." How have you allowed yourself to be inconvenienced in this way?

Next Steps:

- Take the yellow card from the Weekender entitled "I am a 'Sent One'" and if you have not done so already, fill in four environments that you are in (i.e. work, school, sports league, etc.) and put a name down for each environment who you can be praying for. Ask the Holy Spirit to lead you as you are in those environments. Stay alert for opportunities!
