# The Giving Spirit

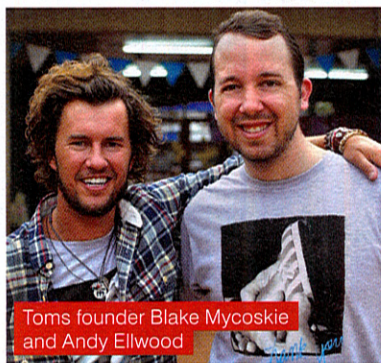
The story of how a million pairs of shoes have changed lives around the world BY ANDY ELLWOOD

IN 2006, BLAKE MYCOSKIE founded Toms Shoes on the simple promise that for every pair of shoes sold, a pair would be donated to charity. Four years later, the millionth pair of shoes has just been given away.

In September I traveled with the team from Toms to Argentina as that benchmark was realized. My company, Gowalla, had just completed a partnership with Toms and AT&T, and this trip was the perfect way to see firsthand the impact we made together. Our teams spent four days in the country's poorest region, giving away shoes and playing with children whose new footwear gave them a newfound sense of freedom.

At the end of our longest day, we delivered shoes to a village deep in the Argentine jungle, on top of a rocky plateau. As I placed a brand-new pair on the feet of a little five-year-old boy, I could tell it was the first time he'd ever worn shoes. As he stood up, his feet wrapped in bright red, he took a couple of timid steps, trying out his new possessions. He turned back and smiled—and then, perhaps for the first time in his life, ran without fear of the rocks underfoot.

Sustainable giving like that of Toms is the future of social change, and I'm proud to be a part of the story.
