3rd Quarter 2013 Report

July

Many of the members remembered that she had led a musical ministry and thanked the Lord for His mercy, for the Church needed a worker in this field. August

We pray and ask for your support for the construction of a new house of worship on the other side of the village of Bilogorodka.

The project design must meet a number of conditions that require time and have difficulty in their implementation. To connect the phone line to the property, it is necessary to perform the technical documentation and output connections for the territory. The land cable that was laid long before goes to the other house. Also we need power lines installed. We proposed a connection to the main distributor, but it is very large and expensive work, but we have come up with another option, and believe it will solve this issue.

And we are very concerned about the issue of gas supply. Bringing gas is one thing, but to dig up from the area two gas lines that pass under the property is much harder and expensive. But, without doing at least these works, we can not put up the fence sections and complete the project of building the house of worship. Therefore, at this time we face a very difficult situation and we ask the Lord for wisdom and support in resolving all these issues.

We also need you to support us in prayer, to further make the right decisions. We also began preparing for evangelistic ministry. It's a big celebration for the church and village -- Harvest Day, or the Feast of

Harvest. We prepare invitations, ads, and are preparing Christian literature, which we will give unbeliever guests invited to this celebration.

We thank the Lord our God and you for your support, brotherly help, and for your prayers. May God richly bless you with His heavenly blessings.

October
