## July 2010 Komariyka

Summer is in full swing, and villagers in our area devote the whole month to a single activity – picking blueberries. We're continuing our studies of the Word of God as well as the services. The congregation of people who attend on a regular basis consists of 10 to 20 people. A Children's Camp was held on the property of the church. We continue preparations for the baptism of Luba and Peter. Church members are strengthened in faith and grow in the knowledge of our Lord. We organize weekly meetings for teens and youth of the village.

#### Borivka

This village has been increasing resistance to the Word. The enemy has not only hindered the villagers, but is also trying very hard to turn members of the local church away from the true path. After a long break, the children who had gone to camp and began to pray and study God's Word on their have begun to come back. ### August 2010 Borivka

In this village, the past month was one of the most difficult in the year. Enemy resistance could be felt and seen. People are closed; the church members are passive; and brother Alex, for whom you pray is clamped in a vise of trials so tightly that he could not go to services without tears.

But along with this the Lord gave a harvest, both on the ground and among children. Again after the summer break, the children come and the children's Bible study continues. They have grown not only physically, but also spiritually. Many of them pray intelligently, they read and study the Word of God with us.

Please pray for the settlement of migrants from the Chernobyl zone, where we want to labor for the Autumn / Spring of 2010 and 2011. Pray too for Thanksgiving holiday on Sept. 19, for the spiritual growth of

Sasha, Nadia and Sveta. For a music ministry among the children and for awakening of souls in the village.

But they hurry to the church to seek shelter from their peers who want to make them like themselves. The Lord placed on the heart of the school directors and parents, and set aside one hour a week for training with the older classes concerning their spiritual-moral development by the light of God's Word.
