### **ACAL National** Council **Meets in Sydney**

The ACAL National Council met in Sydney on June 8-9 for prayer and to discuss our way forward. It was agreed that

each State and Territory ACAL Council member would host at least two Regional Leadership Group gatherings per year in addition to promoting the National Summit. The purpose of regional groups is to build supportive relationships and grapple with local apostolic issues.

e are living in a

time when the

whole Judeo/

Christian foundation of our nation is under satanic attack. In the face of legislative attempts to destroy God's definition of marriage and to destroy our identity as being made male and female in God's image... the wider church is in various stages of compromise, cowardice, confusion, fear and intimidation.

Throughout history God sends apostles and prophets to guide Israel and the nations to turn from sin and idolatry to himself. In this hour, as apostolic and prophetic leaders, ACAL cannot fail to bring the truth of heaven to the nation and provide strong, courageous and visible leadership to the wider church.

There are two governance authorities over the nation, the governance of Christ and the governance of politics. In the British and Australian constitution the governance of Christ prevails over the governance of politics. This is fully compatible with Biblical truth, for example Isaiah 9:6-7.

Will we now surrender the governance of Australia to demonic ideologies - or do we lead the church to arise to its calling under Matt 6:10, Matt 16:18-20 and Col 1:15-20?

In 1933 the German church followed the ideology of Hitler and Nazism and World War 2 was the result.

Today much of the church is following homosexual ideology that is fundamentally anti-Christ in spirit and intent.

So this is the time for ACAL to stand as a shining light of God's plan and purpose for society. We can do none other.

I was asked to say what I saw for the church in Australia in the coming season at the Peace International Apostolic Summit in Rockhampton in May. The following is an extended version of what I shared.

"The people of this world are acutely aware of chronos (natural, linear) time, however as kingdom people we are to discern the *kairos* timing of God on the earth.

"God, who at various times and in various ways spoke in time past to the fathers by the prophets, has in these last days spoken to us by His son, whom He has appointed heir of all things, through whom also He made the worlds;"

#### Hebrews 1:1-2 NKJV

A new day had dawned upon the earth through the arrival of Gods' son in Christ. A new kairos season/ time had dawned on the church and she needed to hear the speaking of God through this new context.

The pioneering stage of this apostolic - prophetic reformation has transitioned into the establishing stage of the work.

We live in a key moment in this nation with regards to God's purposes in the release and expansion of the apostolic prophetic reformation across the

We as a nation have had the

apostolic season breaking in upon us for over 20 years and as a church in the nation we have in general been resistant to this move except for some small pockets of embrace and migration among some churches and ministries.

This season of leanness is now over and the next 20 or so years will not be a repeat of the last 20.

Many Davids in the fields will begin to emerge across this nation. They will be men and women whom God has nurtured and developed in the back fields of the kingdom out of sight.

"Thus Jesse made seven of his sons pass before Samuel. And Samuel said to Jesse, "The LORD has not chosen these." And Samuel said to Jesse, "Are all the young men here?" Then he said, "There remains yet the youngest, and there he is, keeping the sheep." And Samuel said to Jesse, "Send and bring him. For we will not sit down till he comes here.""

#### I Samuel 16:10-11 NKJV

Their hearts have been tested and their integrity proven towards the Lord through seasons of loneliness and obscurity.

God will begin to sovereignly link these emerging champions in the Lord relationally, they will begin to find one another and stand with each other, accelerating the work of God in reformation dramatically.

"Then the Spirit came upon Amasai, chief of the captains, and he said: "We are yours, O David; We are on vour side, O son of Jesse! Peace, peace to you, and peace to your helpers! For your God helps you." So David received them, and made them captains of the troop."

#### I Chronicles 12:18 NKJV

As a result of this apostolic synergy many who begin to migrate into this move of God will be upgraded and configured at a much greater speed than those who embraced this move in the pioneering stage.

"And about the eleventh hour he went out and found others standing idle, and said to them, Why have you been standing here idle all day?' They said to him, 'Because no one hired us.' He said to them, You also go into the vineyard, and whatever is right vou will receive.' saying, 'These last men have worked only one hour, and you made them equal to us who have borne the burden and the heat of the day.'

So the last will be first, and the first last. For many are called, but few chosen."

This will manifest itself in a mighty releasing dimension upon the saints, sending them powerfully into the marketplace equipped, anointed and configured to become champions in the land!


