

TRIANGLE QUILT PATTERN designed by Amy Smart & Sarah Jane Studio



Fabric requirements:

12 different 1/4 yards of fabric for the triangles
1 yard fabric for the border (cut into 6 strips, 5" x 42")
1/2 yard for binding (cut into 7 strips, 2 1/2" x 42")
3 3/4 yards for back

Supplies required:

8 1/2" tall 60 degree triangle template/ruler

Instructions:

Trim each 1/4 yard piece to 8 1/2" x 42".

Using the triangle template or ruler, starting 2" away from the selvage edge, cut 7 triangles by rotating the template. Save the half-triangle 'wedge' at the beginning (left-side wedge) and the end (right-side wedge) of each strip.

Left-side wedge

Repeat with all 1/4 yard cuts.

You will need: 77 triangles, 10 left-side wedges, and 8 right-side wedges.

Quilt Layout:

Starting with a right side wedge, lay out 11 alternating triangles, finishing with a left-side wedge. Sew triangles together, pressing seams to the left.



For row 2 start with a left-side wedge, layout 11 alternating triangles, finishing with a right-side wedge. Sew triangles together, pressing seams to the right.



Repeat alternating rows for a total of 7 rows. Press seams to the left on odd rows and to the right on even rows.

Sew rows together in sequence and press seams all the same direction.

Square-off sides of quilt leaving space for an 1/4" seam allowance.



Attach borders, quilt, and bind using your preferred methods. Enjoy!

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
