Sponsorship Benefit Details

Welcome Remarks – The Title Sponsor will be invited to participate in opening remarks with a statement of up to 5 minutes.

Naming Rights for First Place Award – The Title Sponsor will have naming rights for the first place award.

Company Logo on Name Badges – Title level sponsors will have their logos displayed on all participant name badges.

Placement In Printed Participant Packets – Youth participants will receive a printed Student Participant Packet, and adult participants will receive a printed Mentor Participant Packet. Title and Platinum level sponsors will receive full-page ads in the participant packets, and Gold level sponsors will receive a half page ad. In addition, Title and Platinum level sponsors will have their logos placed on the front page of participant packets. All other sponsors will have their names listed in the participant packets.

Invitation to Judge At Final Pitch – Title and Platinum level sponsors will be invited to provide a judge to serve on the judge's panel during the final pitch presentations by each team. Additional community leaders may also be placed on the judging panel.

Company Name in Press Release – Title, Platinum, and Gold and level sponsors will be listed in major press releases about the event.

Placement on Sponsor Page of Website – Title, Platinum, and Gold level sponsors will be placed on the sponsor page of the website with up to a 100 word description. Silver and Bronze level sponsors will be placed on the sponsor page of the website with up to a 50 word description.

Exhibit Tables – Exhibit tables are six feet wide with electricity and wireless internet provided. Table coverings are not provided. A maximum of two exhibit table staff may be present per day.

Distribution of Promotional Materials During Event – Company promotional items, fliers or electronic profiles are allowed for disbursement among Hack4Hope participants (only) in the venue.

Promoted Tweets – We will send out the promoted tweets on the Hack4Hope Twitter account. You specify the tweet and the schedule. The tweets must be sent to the Hack4Hope team prior to the conference and at least 72 hours prior to when you want them scheduled to be posted. The tweets are subject to approval by the Hack4Hope communications team.
