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Magical Mara

2 NIGHTS MARA INTREPIDS – SILVER

Experience the iconic Maasai Mara, legendary for its abundance of wildlife and being big cat country all year round.

OVERVIEW

Mara Intrepids is on one of the best sites in the Maasai Mara for seeing the annual wildebeest migration. Its thirty tents are erected on raised wooden platforms, giving guests wonderful views over the Maasai Mara where all of the Big Five can be seen within a few miles of the camp. The staff at Intrepids are particularly good with children who can often get bored – even of megafauna! – on a long game drive. There's plenty here for them to do, including swimming in the large pool and exciting nature walks with experienced guides.

The modern tents at Intrepids are stylishly designed with romantic draped four-poster beds and canvas walls that can be rolled up in the heat of the day. Every tent has its own veranda and en-suite bathroom, complete with every modern amenity. The camp is cleverly divided into four so that it retains a great deal of intimacy and exclusivity that some of the larger lodges and camps lose.

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Rugged Samburu

2 NIGHTS LARSENS CAMP - GOLD

Samburu National Reserve offers what is arguably Kenya's greatest - and least changed - encounter with the wild Africa of yesteryear.

OVERVIEW

Larsen's Camp is a small luxury camp in the Samburu National Reserve. Just twenty tents line the Ewaso Nyiro River and are surrounded by forest and bush. Beautifully decorated with rich carpets, campaign furniture and simple Amerikani calico curtains and bedspreads, the light and airy tents all have their own private decks where guests can enjoy watching the sun rise across the river. There's twenty four hour hot water and electricity.

The Ewaso Nyiro attracts large quantities of game from all over the arid North. Rare genet and Grevy's zebra can be seen here, as can elusive Beisa Oryx. Samburu is well known for its large elephant population. They often come to swim and drink in the river below the camp. Fabulous meals are served on the two decks, in the bush or down by the river.

Picnic lunches can be ordered anywhere. There is a resident naturalist at Larsen's who takes guests on exciting nature walks, showing them the abundant bird life, the tracks of animals that have passed in the night and other signposts of the bush.

The Amboseli Serena has a large swimming pool and on most nights guests can have dinner overlooking a watering hole accompanied by traditional dancing by Maasai warriors from the surrounding area. At an extra cost, it is also possible to visit local manyatta villages, and see how the Maasai live.

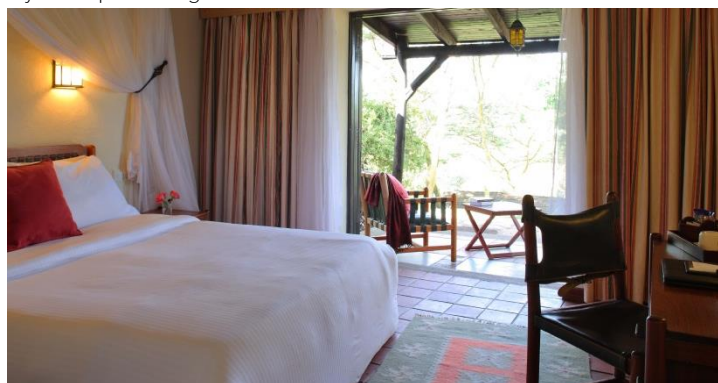
OVERVIEW

The **Sarova Lion Hill** Game Lodge is one of only two lodges in Lake Nakuru National Park. Here just a few hours drive from Nairobi, travellers can see the spectacle of a million pink flamingos, wading in one of Kenya's glorious Great Rift Valley Lakes. And in the park that surrounds the lake, a lot of plains game abound.

The Lion Hill Game Lodge is set on a small plateau and commands breathtaking views over the lake. Its sixty-four rooms are simply but tastefully decorated and all have views of the flamingo-bordered lake. The rooms have en-suite bathrooms and private patios. The Lion Hill is a great place to take kids, with plenty of activities, ranging from nature walks and table tennis to archery. There's nightly tribal dancing and other entertainment and a swimming pool and sauna. The lodge can organise special meals in the bush and sundowners overlooking the lake at an extra cost.

OVERVIEW

Lake Nakuru Lodge is an impressive property with a dramatic back-drop. An ornithologist's paradise, the lake is home to 400 species of birdlife and an abundance of fish and the water life. The surrounding landscape is host to the giraffe, buffalo and zebra. In the lake itself, greater and lesser flamingos mingle freely, an environment which the lake is famous for. The resort blends in perfectly with its natural surroundings. It is an ideal base from which to explore the surrounding countryside and nearby Lake Nakuru National Park. The lodge provides 68 rooms and suites with 120 beds. All the family rooms, cottages and suites have balconies that overlook the park. The lodge has provisions for single and double or twin bedrooms with large four poster beds and modern en-suite bathrooms. There are plenty of activities offered at the lodge that include game drives, safari excursions, horse-riding and bird-watching.

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Day Trip to Lake Nakuru National Park

LAKE NAKURU NATIONAL PARK

Lake Nakuru National Park earned its fame as the home of the greatest avian spectacle in the world.

OVERVIEW

Lake Nakuru, a shallow and alkaline lake on the bed of the Great Rift Valley, has earned its fame as the home of the greatest bird spectacle in the world - flocks of often more than a million pink flamingos which seasonally use its waters to feed on the abundant algae which thrives in its shallow warm waters. Although the flamingo are the most obvious, other inhabitants of the alkaline lake include Black-winged stilts, avocets and in the European winter a mass of ruffs. Lake Nakuru National Park has a great deal to offer. Beside its magnificent bird life, it is also a rhino sanctuary and one of the best places in the country to see both black and white rhino. The park is also home to lion, leopard, buffalo and other plains and forest game who have made it their permanent and protected habitat. The acacia savannah which surrounds the lake is itself beautiful and provides an area which is particularly good for game viewing.

PROGRAM

Pick from your city centre hotel at 0800 hrs. approx.. Drive past Lake Naivasha and Lake Elementaita to Lake Nakuru National Park. Enjoy a game viewing/bird watching drive around the lakeshore.

Lunch at the Sarova Lion Hill Game Lodge.

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NAIROBI EXCURSIONS

HALF DAY TOUR OF GIRAFFE CENTRE & KAREN BLIXEN-DEP 0800/1400

Giraffe Centre is the headquarters for AFEW, the African Fund for Endangered Wildlife. Made famous by 'Daisy Rothschild', a giraffe calf rescued from Soi, on the border of Western Kenya, Giraffe Centre was established in 1983 as a sanctuary for the then endangered Rothschild giraffe. The breeding programme has been a great success and visitors can now watch these gentle giants at eye level from a raised platform. There is also the opportunity to learn more about giraffe at the interpretation centre and hand-feed them whilst watching the semi-tame family of warthogs snuffle around their hooves in search of tidbits.

Located in Karen, the beautiful Nairobi suburb which was once part of Karen Blixen's vast coffee estate, 'Mbogani' was Karen's home from 1917 until 1931. The house and grounds were made famous by the film 'Out of Africa' and have been restored by the Danish community of Kenya. Visitors have a glimpse of typical colonial life in Kenya at the turn of the twentieth century. As well as many of Karen's original belongings, replicas replace items which have been lost over the years. From the beautiful gardens there are magnificent views of the Ngong Hills, held dear by Karen and described so tenderly in her writings. At the front of the house the original millstone tables can be seen from which Karen conducted much of her farm business.

HALF DAY VISIT TO DAVID SHELDRIK ANIMAL ORPHANAGE- DEP 0900

Dame Daphne Sheldrick started the Elephant and sometimes, rhino, orphanage in honour of her late husband David, the Warden of 6,000 square mile Tsavo National Park where they lived and raised orphans of every species at their home. The Orphanage is on the edge of Nairobi National Park where the youngsters feed in their mini herds with a mini Matriarch every day, coming back three times a day for their milk feeding and in hot weather, a mud bath. Visitors can see this at 1100 hrs possibly along with a few schoolchildren! There is a semi private encounter with them again at 1700 hrs when they come in for their bed time feed and sleep.

Each elephant sleeps with a ranger, who alternate between the 20-30 orphans found there at any time, to prevent the orphans becoming too attached to one person. All this is explained by a head keeper during the visit as are the harrowing stories of how many became orphans, mostly the result of poaching. They also explain what happened when the residents reach the age of three or four and graduate to the next stage, a release site in Tsavo. This is the most famous, the largest and most successful elephant Orphanage in Africa and even during a short visit you can see what wonderful personalities they are, and everyone is different. You can tell the difference between one who came from high altitude and one from low altitude.

HALF DAY TOUR OF NAIROBI NATIONAL PARK-DEP 0800/1400

Unbelievably close to the human bustle of the city, this is an important wildlife reserve (Kenya's first, in fact), if only because it provides an opportunity to catch a first look at lions, leopards, buffaloes, and rhinos (no elephants, I'm afraid) during those precious hours before jetting back home or when first arriving or if only staying in Nairobi -- this is surely one of the easiest game drive opportunities on Earth. The reserve is also an important breeding center for the endangered black rhino and home to more than 100 different sorts of mammals, with as many as 400 species of birds recorded. Incorporating important migration corridors, animal concentrations are best during the dry season, which theoretically runs from January through March but is fairly unpredictable these days. In fact, if your flight into Kenya arrives by daylight, try to spot game during those final moments before touchdown. The park will give you a chance for close-quarters animal viewing.
