



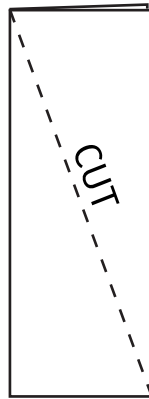
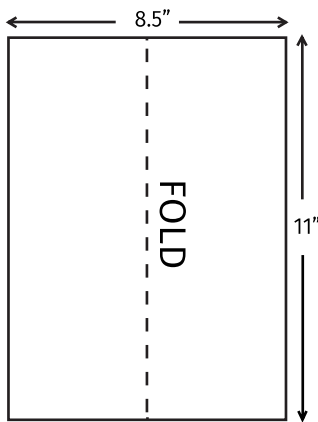
THUMBKIT

what you need:

- One sheet of 8.5 x 11" cardstock
- 1/4 yard unbleached muslin (some craft stores require a 2 yard minimum)
- One black VersaCraft™ stamp ink pad

instructions:

1. Fold your cardstock vertically.
2. Moving from the outside edge to the creased edge, cut from corner to corner.
3. Use this cardstock triangle as a guide for cutting your fabric into a triangle penant. You need one penant per every 25 thumbprints. Leave 2.5" of unused space at the top of the flag.



4. Share Esperance's story with your friends, family and coworkers. Use resources on our web site to educate them about the problem of violence against women in war.
5. Including your own, gather 25 unique thumbprints per flag triangle. Explain that this flag will be one of many delivered to decision-makers like the United Nations as an act of advocacy, proclaiming that grassroots peace for women experiencing violence in war must be a priority.
6. Including yourself, have each person record their name and email address (optional) on the attached form.
7. You may also collect small donations. For cash donations, write a check for the total amount and make it out to Together International with "One Million Thumbprints" in the memo line.
8. Mail the flag, form and checks to **Together International at PO Box 900 Columbia, MD 21044.**
