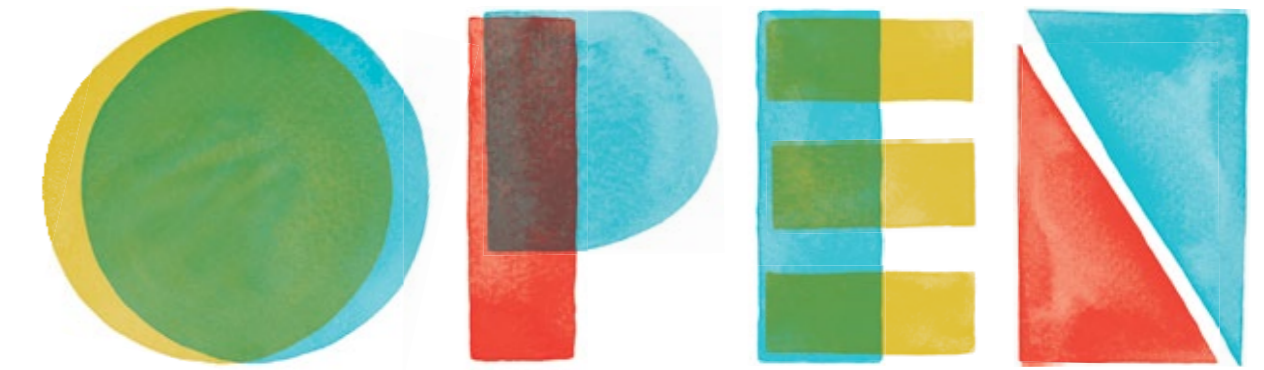

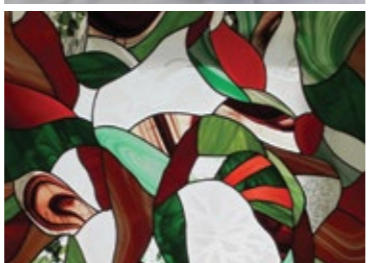
**13 JULIE MOSELEN**

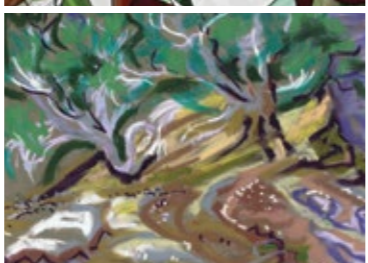
**14 KAREN KENNEDY & CHRISTINE BARRY**

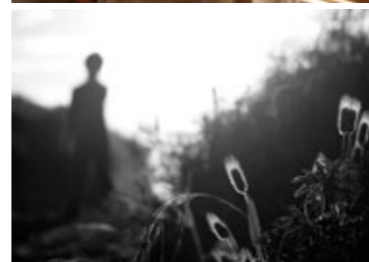
**19 PAMELA BYLES**

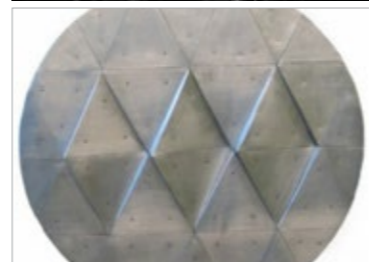
**20 PETER BRIERLEY-MILLMAN**

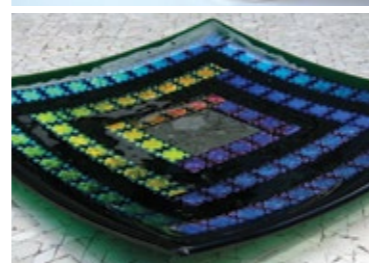
**22 RENE JANSEN**

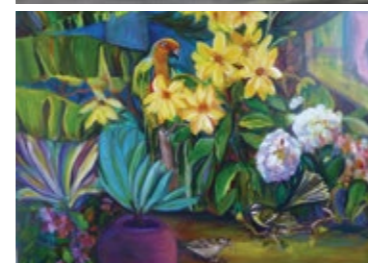

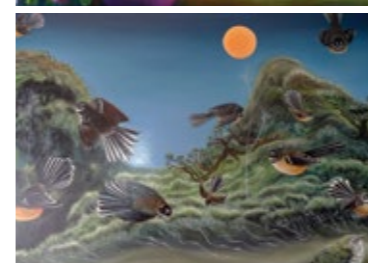

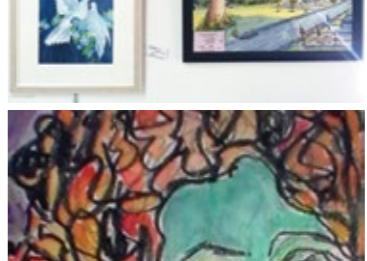
