## ARC Resources Interpretive Wetlands Northeast

This 3.1 hectare natural wetland is directly adjacent to the east Rotary/Mattamy Greenway and is home to an array of plants and animals. It is a significant wetland along the Greenway and will become a major destination for Calgarians to learn about our fragile watershed. The Rotary/Mattamy Greenway continues North and South of the Wetlands through the community of Monterey Park.

## Directions to ARC Resources Interpretive Wetlands

### South Access to Wetlands & Greenway

1. Drive east on 32<sup>nd</sup> Ave NE
2. Left turn at Catalina Blvd NE

Access to the Wetland area is at the end of 32<sup>nd</sup> Ave NE.

### North Access to Wetlands & Greenway

1. Drive east on 32<sup>nd</sup> Ave NE
2. Left turn at Catalina Blvd NE
3. Right turn on Laguna Way NE

Access to the Greenway is at the playground just after Anaheim Crescent NE; turn right on pathway intersection to access the Wetlands.

Parking is available in residential areas.

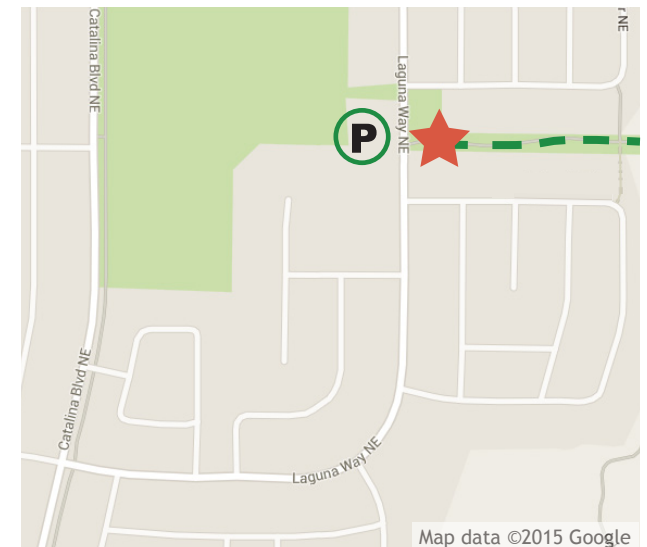
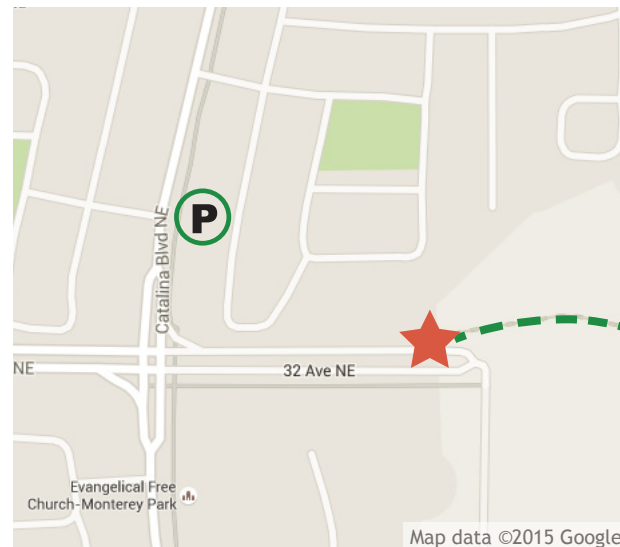
