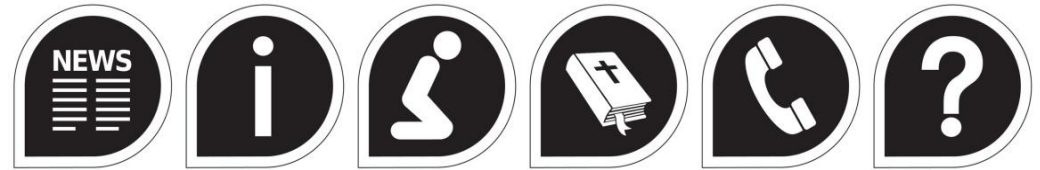
### This Week's Question
