Read Acts 19: 23 - 41

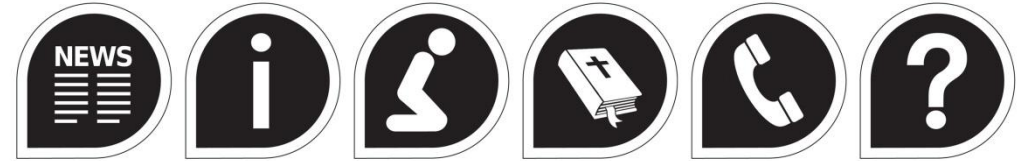
PRAYER IN THE BEACON CENTRE
