Read Genesis 4: 2b - 5

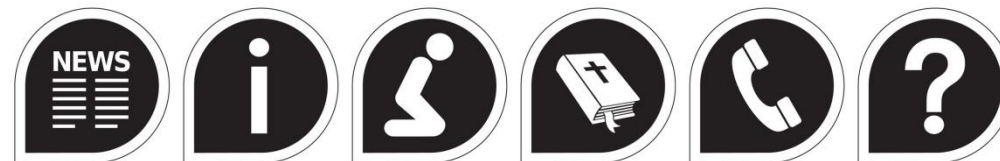


PRAYER IN THE BEACON CENTRE
