Marsha Farney *claims to be a conservative*, however her record in the Texas House paints an entirely different picture:



An independent study conducted by Rice University professor Mark Jones suggests that **Marsha Farney was the 9<sup>th</sup> most liberal of 98 Republicans** in the Texas House.<sup>1</sup>



Farney supported the 2013 state budget which **increased state spending by 26%** and included a \$4 billion withdrawal from our state's savings account, The Rainy Day Fund.<sup>2</sup>



Farney **stood with liberal Democrats** in watering down key **Second Amendment legislation**.<sup>3</sup>



Farney supported an amendment that would have **expanded Medicaid under Obamacare** in Texas.<sup>4</sup>
