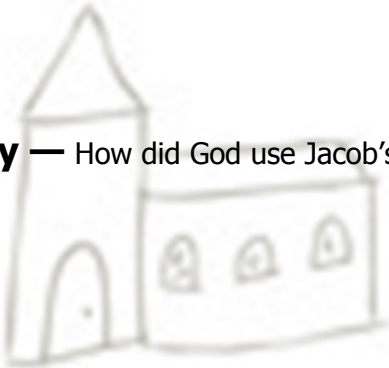
DAILY READINGS
