Discovering Your Spiritual Gifts (Christian Principles Class 8 of 9)

We will take 25 minutes and learn what our spiritual gifts seem to be. This will be easy. A statement will appear. Inside 15 seconds, please rate that statement as it describes you.

On page 2 you'll see the key. After each statement is read, write in the rating number telling how well that statement describes you. The ratings are from 0 to 4. Zero means not at all and 4 means that you agree strongly with the statement.

There are 100 questions, if you miss any, no problem. Skip it and at the end you can ask for a statement to be reread and then answer it. This is not a test or trickery. There are no wrong answers.
