BLUE INN ON THE BEACH

Massachusetts

This lodge updates the classic New England look with a purist blue and white aesthetic. There are rooms with sea views, cottages set around a garden and a beachfront villa, with cosy touches like wood-burning stoves and outdoor Jacuzzis. The whitewashed inn opens straight onto wild flowerspeckled sand dunes that slope down to the beach. A haven for twitchers, the barrier Plum Island is known for its migratory birdlife.

BUNGALOW New Jersey

Bungalow's room names – Aloha, L'il Pipeline, Kahuna and Hang Loose – belie a hotel that is actually more city-chic hangout than surf shack. Opened earlier this month on the Jersey Shore, its rooms are dazzling white, with original artwork, kitchenettes and fresh cut flowers. There's also a beachside pool which doubles as a bar area in the evenings, as well as a swanky restaurant. HOTEL GREEN

Massachusetts

Owned by shoe designer Vanessa Noel, this hotel in well-heeled Nantucket sits next to her neighbouring eponymous hotel in the Historic District. One-off pieces of furniture and stylish decor keep things cool. The harbour and sandy beaches are close by.

HIDDEN POND Maine

Hidden Pond's 14 cottages are scattered around a forest just a mile from Goose Rocks Beach. Guests can make use of bicycles, go on beach safaris, gather produce from the resort's organic farm or just relax in the tented spa. The decor of the cottages ranges from urban chic to mountain lodge and each of them comes with an outdoor shower and floor-to-ceiling windows.

THE SURF LODGE

New York

Opened yesterday, The Surf Lodge brings retro appeal to Montauk, a laid-back fishing village in the otherwise ritzy Hamptons. It's decked out with bright prints, driftwood art, vintage globes, hurricane lamps and black-and-white photos, while classic film screenings and board games contribute to the relaxed ambience. A deck and cocktail bar overlooking a pond will pick up the pace with live music in the evenings.
