
## 8-STATE RE-ENTRY / REINTEGRATION CONFERENCE: STONY POINT, NY

We will focus on the trauma of incarceration, how it impacts 3 areas of Re-Entry: Jobs, Housing, Family Reintegration, and which trauma-informed ministries are addressing these areas effectively. Most of the speakers will be the men and women who were formerly incarcerated.
