Regional Attractions

- Two 18-hole golf courses are located approximately 4 miles NE of the site
- Nisqually National Wildlife Refuge
 - 3,700 acres and is approximately 4.5 miles east of our site, on the north side of I-5
 - Estimated Annual Visitors 200,000
- Regional Athletic Complex
 - Less than 3 miles south of our site is a 100-acre Regional Athletic Complex comprised of five softball/baseball/fastpitch fields, six regulation size soccer/football/rugby fields, picnic and outdoor facilities, playgrounds, walking trails, concessions, and parking for 500 vehicles
 - Estimated Annual Visitors 207,500
 - People who traveled more than 50 miles 70%
 - Estimated number of hotel room nights generated 6,675

Regional Unemployment/Government Workers/Daytime Population

- The unemployment rate as of April 2014 was 5.7% in Thurston County
- The government employs approximately 36,000 workers in the county as of April 2014
- Daytime employment within 15 minutes of our site is approximately 89,000

Joint Base Lewis-McChord (data as of Dec. 2012 below)


- 9 miles east of our site
- Supports 116,773 soldiers, airmen, dependents, employees, and contract employees in addition to the 117,971 military retirees already present
- Total military personnel is 60,585: 46,208 military, 14,377 civilian
- JBLM is the 2nd largest employer in Washington after Boeing
- Total Annual JBLM Economic Impact: \$6,085,323,000 (approximately 1.8% of Washington State GDP)



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Meridian Campus Development/Distribution Facility Employment

- The Meridian Campus Master Planned Community is a 1,312-acre development to the east of our site, also on the north side of I-5
- Meridian Campus has two elementary schools and one middle school
- Estimated employment within distribution facilities in Meridian Campus & immediate vicinity:



- Trader Joe's Distribution 350 400
- Target 300
- Home Depot 250
- Harbor Wholesale 200

Housing

- Residential map (shown left) includes the number of developments and lots, and their development status
- Generally, the homes around the golf courses are selling for between \$400,000 - \$525,000 and are more than 6,000 SF in size; lots off of the golf courses vary more in price depending on their size, etc.

There are two planned housing developments that directly share a parcel line with us:

- Britton Place
 - 36 acres to the north with 167 single family home lots and 210-unit market rate apartments planned
- Taylor Development
 - 123 acres to the north
 - 800-850 properties
 - 600 single family, 4,000 SF lots
 - 250 apartment units
 - In final stages of entitlement now, and began marketing in July of 2014
 - Construction is slated to occur in 2015
 - The price points will be \$245,000 and up

Schools

- North Thurston Public Schools educate over 14,000 students each year, with thirteen elementary schools, four middle schools (including a performing arts magnet school), three comprehensive high schools and one high school of choice
- JBLM has eight preschools, four elementary schools, four public schools and four private schools that make up the Clover Park School District, where more than 12,000 students are enrolled



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
